FDOT Palm Beach County Traffic Report

September 15 – September 22, 2023

PALM BEACH COUNTY, Fla. – Palm Beach County traffic will be affected this week by ongoing construction projects and maintenance work, Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) officials report. Closures will be in effect on I-95 and in other areas throughout Palm Beach County for construction activities. Please note, that any full road, ramp, or bridge closures have been highlighted below.

CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

INTERSTATE 95

1. **I-95 from south of Glades Road to south of Linton Boulevard and SR 808/Glades Road from NW 22nd Way to West University Drive in the Cities of Boca Raton and Delray Beach (95 Express Phase 3B-2)**

Description: 95 Express Lanes Phase 3B-2 will extend the existing Express Lanes north from just south of Glades Road to just south of Linton Boulevard in Palm Beach County. One lane will be added, and the High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) lane will be converted to create two Express Lanes in each direction. The number of General Use lanes will remain the same. Access to the Express Lanes will be provided via two designated ingress and egress locations—between Glades Road and Congress Avenue. The scope of work includes reconfiguration of the SR 808/Glades Road Interchange to a Diverging Diamond Interchange (DDI). Additional project improvements include overhead sign structure installation, Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) and Express Lane markers, new signalization, lighting, signing and pavement markings, and ramp signalization at five interchanges from Glades Road to Linton Boulevard. Shoulder-mounted sound barrier walls will be constructed along I-95 northbound between Clint Moore Road and Linton Boulevard, ground-mounted sound walls will be installed on the south side of Yamato Road east of I-95 adjacent to the University Heights Community and along I-95 northbound south of Linton Boulevard adjacent to the Tierra Verde Community. The Clint Moore Road Bridge over I-95 will be fully reconstructed and the Glades Road bridge over the South Florida Regional Transportation Authority (SFRTA) railroad tracks and Military Trail and the I-95 bridge over the C-15 Canal (between Peninsula Drive and Linton Boulevard) will be widened. Cost/Completion: \$148 million. Completion is expected in late 2023.

I-95 Traffic Impact:

- I-95 will have up to four lanes closed in each direction nightly, 9 p.m. until 5:30 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. The first lane will close at 9 p.m., the second lane will close at 9:30 p.m., and the third and fourth lane will close at 11 p.m.

Glades Road Impact:

- The SR-808/Glades Road and I-95 interchange is in a new Diverging Diamond configuration. Please use caution as you approach the interchange – the posted speed is 35 MPH. Keep the crossover intersections clear like you would on any other roadway.

Military Trail Impact:

- No impacts anticipated.

Ramp Impact:

- The I-95 northbound entrance ramp from westbound Glades Road will be closed nightly as needed, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via westbound Glades Road, Jog Road, and Yamato Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- The I-95 northbound entrance ramp from eastbound Glades Road will be closed nightly as needed, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via eastbound Glades Road, N Federal Highway, and Yamato Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- The I-95 southbound entrance ramp from westbound Glades Road will be closed nightly as needed, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via westbound Glades Road, Powerline Road, and Palmetto Park Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- The I-95 southbound entrance from eastbound Glades Road will be closed as needed, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via eastbound [Glades Road, US-1](#)/Federal Highway and Palmetto Park Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- The I-95 northbound exit ramp to Spanish River Boulevard will be closed nightly as needed, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via I-95 north, Yamato Road

- east, N Federal Highway, and Spanish River Boulevard. FHP will be onsite to assist motorists.
- The I-95 northbound entrance ramp from Congress Avenue and Peninsula Corp. Drive will be closed nightly as needed, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via southbound I-95 and Yamato Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
 - The I-95 northbound exit ramp to Congress Avenue will be closed nightly as needed, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via I-95 and Linton Boulevard. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
 - The I-95 northbound exit ramp to Yamato Road will be closed nightly as needed, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via Congress Avenue/Peninsula Corp Drive, Congress Avenue, and Yamato Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
 - The I-95 southbound exit ramp to Yamato Road/Spanish River Blvd will be closed nightly as needed, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via Peninsula Corp Dr, Congress Ave. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
 - The I-95 southbound entrance ramp from eastbound Yamato Road will be closed nightly as needed, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via eastbound Yamato Road, US-1/Federal Highway south, westbound Glades Road, and the I-95 southbound entrance ramp from Glades Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
 - The I-95 southbound entrance ramp from westbound Yamato Road will be closed nightly as needed, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via westbound Yamato Road, Congress Ave, Peninsula Corp Drive, and the I-95 southbound entrance ramp from Peninsula Corp Drive. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
 - The I-95 southbound entrance ramp from Peninsula Corp Drive will be closed nightly as needed, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via Congress Avenue and Yamato Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.

Clint Moore Road Impact:

- No impacts anticipated.

Yamato Road Impact:

- No impacts anticipated.

2. Belvedere Road Improvements at the I-95 Northbound On/Off-Ramp Connection

Description: Project improvements consist of adding a second right-turn lane on the SR 9/I-95 northbound exit ramp to eastbound Belvedere Road, widening, milling, resurfacing and adding a paved shoulder to the existing SR 9/I-95 northbound exit ramp to Belvedere Road, installing new mast arms assemblies and pedestrian countdown signals, implementing a Wrong Way Driving Countermeasure System, Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) upgrades, new sidewalk construction on the south side of Belvedere Road from the exit ramp to eastern project limits, new signalization, lighting, curbs, gutter and drainage improvements, new fencing and sod installation. Cost/Completion: \$2.4 million. Completion is expected in Summer 2024.

Traffic Impact:

- The I-95 northbound entrance ramp from Belvedere Road may have one inside lane closed daily, 9:30 a.m. until 3:30 p.m., and nightly, 9:30 p.m. until 5:30 a.m.
- Belvedere Road at I-95 may have one outside lane closed in each direction, daily 9:30 a.m. until 3:30 p.m., and nightly, 9:30 p.m. until 5:30 a.m.

3. I-95 Southbound Off-Ramp to Belvedere Road

Description: This 0.5-mile project in West Palm Beach will begin September 18, 2023. Improvements include widening SR 9/I-95 southbound to lengthen the off-ramp deceleration lane, installing speed feedback signs to provide drivers' traveling speed compared to the posted speed limit, providing a High Friction Surface Treatments on the SR 9/I-95 southbound off-ramp, implementing a Wrong-Way Driving detection system, replacing impacted sign structures and upgrading pavement markings and signage.

I-95 Traffic Impact:

- I-95 southbound from south of SR 704/Okeechobee Boulevard to the I-95 southbound exit ramp to Belvedere Road, may have three outside lanes closed nightly, 10 p.m. until 6 a.m., Monday, Sept. 18 through Thursday, Sept. 21.

Ramp Impact:

- The I-95 southbound exit ramp to Belvedere Road will be closed overnight, 10 p.m. until 6 a.m., Wednesday, Sept. 20. Motorists will be detoured to Belvedere Road via westbound SR 80/Southern Boulevard and northbound Australian Avenue. Thursday, Sept. 21 will be used as contingency if needed.
- The I-95 southbound exit ramp to Palm Beach International Airport (PBI) will be closed overnight, 10 p.m. until 6 a.m., Thursday, Sept. 21. Motorists will be detoured to PBI via westbound SR 80/Southern Boulevard and northbound Australian Avenue. Sunday, Sept. 24 will be used as contingency if needed.
- **Advanced Notice:** The I-95 southbound exit ramp to Palm Beach International Airport (PBI) will be closed overnight, 10 p.m. until 6 a.m., Sunday, Sept. 24. Motorists will be detoured to PBI via westbound SR 80/Southern Boulevard and northbound Australian Avenue. Monday, Sept. 25 be used as contingency if needed.

4. I-95 from south of 10th Avenue North to north of SR 882/Forest Hill Boulevard Safety Improvements Project

Description: This 2.75-mile project located in West Palm Beach and Lake Worth Beach began on August 10, 2022. Improvements include milling and resurfacing segments of I-95 in both directions, installing new signage, including an overhead Dynamic Message Sign on I-95 northbound just south of 10th Avenue North, upgrading existing lighting with LED luminaires and installing a new Road Weather Information System (RWIS). Traffic Impact:

- **Advanced Notice:** I-95 northbound just north of Lake Worth Road may have up to three outside lanes closed, 10 p.m. until 5:30 a.m., Monday, Sept. 25. Tuesday, Sept. 26 and Wednesday, Sept. 27 will be used as contingency if needed.

5. I-95 Lighting & Safety Improvements from Palm Beach Lakes Boulevard to 45th Street

Description: This 3.95-mile project in West Palm Beach began in July. Improvements include replacing the existing High-Pressure Sodium (HPS) roadway lighting with light-emitting diode (LED) roadway lighting along the I-95 mainline and installing a Road Weather Information System (RWIS) on the I-95 southbound exit ramp to Palm Beach Lakes Boulevard.

I-95 Traffic Impact:

- I-95 between Palm Beach Lakes Boulevard and 45th Street will have the inside and outside shoulders closed in each direction as needed, daily, 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., Monday through Friday.
- The I-95 southbound entrance and exit ramps at Palm Beach Lakes Boulevard will have the outside shoulder closed as needed, daily, 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., Monday through Friday.
- The I-95 northbound entrance and exit ramps at Palm Beach Lakes Boulevard will have the outside shoulder closed as needed, daily, 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., Monday through Friday.
- The I-95 southbound entrance and exit ramps at 45th Street will have the outside shoulder closed as needed, daily, 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., Monday through Friday.

The I-95 northbound entrance and exit ramps at 45th Street will have the outside shoulder closed as needed, daily, 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., Monday through Friday

6. SR 9/I-95 at SR 786/PGA Boulevard Southbound Entrance Ramps Project

Description: This 0.65-mile project in Palm Beach Gardens began on November 9, 2022. Improvements consist of reconfiguring the I-95 southbound entrance ramps at PGA Boulevard. The I-95 southbound entrance ramp from westbound PGA Boulevard to southbound I-95 will be converted from a merge lane to an additional, free-flowing lane. The I-95 southbound entrance ramp from eastbound PGA Boulevard to southbound I-95 will be reconfigured to become a merge lane. In addition, I-95 will be widened between PGA Boulevard and Burns Road, and lighting, drainage, signage and pavement markings will be upgraded. (BOCA RATON, HIGHLAND BEACH, DELRAY BEACH)

7. Dynamic Envelope Marking Rail Safety Project

Description: Construction on this railroad marking project will take place at Tommy Clements Street, SW Silver Fox Lane, and SW Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Drive in Indiantown, Innovation Drive in Jupiter, Aviation Road in West Palm Beach, Larrimore Road in Pahokee, Gator Boulevard/Airport Road, NW 12th Street/Osceola Street, W Canal Street, NW Avenue D, SW Avenue E/Dr. M.L.K. Jr. Boulevard W in Belle Glade, NW 1st Avenue in South Bay, and Miami Canal Road in Lake Harbor is began on August 28, 2023. Work includes milling and resurfacing the pavement, installing signage, pavement markings, and sod, and performing utility adjustments.

Cost/Completion: \$1.1 million/Early 2024

Traffic Impacts:

- The eastbound and westbound lanes of Aviation Boulevard at SR 710/Bee Line Highway will be closed to traffic beginning 8 p.m., Wednesday, Sept. 20, until 8 a.m., Thursday, Sept. 21. The full closure will begin with one lane closing at 6 p.m., with flaggers directing traffic until both directions are closed at 8 p.m. During this time, no local traffic will be able to use Aviation Boulevard to enter or exit North Palm Beach County General Aviation Airport.
- **Advance Notice:** Both eastbound and westbound lanes of SW Tommy Clements Street at SR 710/ SW Warfield Boulevard will be closed to traffic, beginning at 8 p.m., Thursday, Sept. 28 until 8 a.m., Friday morning, Sept. 29. During this time, no local traffic will be able to use SW Tommy Clements Street to enter or exit the community. The full closure will begin with one lane closing at 6 p.m., with flaggers directing traffic until both directions are closed at 8 p.m. Flaggers will be available to escort school bus riders and pedestrians to SR 710/ SW Warfield Boulevard as needed.

8. Advanced Transportation Management System (ATMS) Project

Description: This 6-mile project from the Broward/Palm Beach County Line to SR 794/Yamato Road and SR 794/Yamato Road from SR 5/US 1 to SR 9/I-95 in the city of Boca Raton began on July 31, 2023. Work includes installing a new fiber optic network, Intelligent Transportation System (ITS)

devices, including Closed-Circuit Television (CCTV) devices at eight (8) intersections on US 1 from Royal Palm Way to Spanish River Boulevard, upgrading the signal detection system, and upgrading the Advance Traffic Management System (ATMS) for compatibility with the Traffic Management Center (TMC).

Cost/Completion: \$3.6 million. Completion is expected in summer 2024.

Traffic Impacts:

- The outside northbound lane of SR 5/US 1 from the Broward/Palm Beach County Line to Royal Palm Way will be closed nightly, Monday through Sunday, from 10:00 p.m. until 6:30 a.m. to install fiber optic and ITS equipment.
- One westbound lane of Yamato Road from SR 5/US 1 to I-95 may be closed nightly, Monday through Sunday, from 11:00 p.m. until 7:00 a.m. for the installation of fiber optic and ITS equipment. 9. State Road (SR) 5/US 1 Improvements Project

Description: This 0.437-mile road improvements project on SR 5/US 1 from North Quadrille Boulevard to Palm Beach Lakes Boulevard in the City of West Palm Beach began on Thursday, September 14, 2023. Work includes milling and resurfacing the existing roadway, improving curb and gutter, signing and pavement markings, upgrading pedestrian curb ramps to meet Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards, and upgrading pedestrian signalization.

Cost/Completion: 1.2 million/Spring 2024

10. SR 802/Lake Worth Road Improvements Project

Description: This 1.90-mile project from Raulerson Drive to Palm Beach State College Entrance/Douglas Drive in the city of Lake Worth Beach began on Monday, November 14, 2022. Work includes constructing a new exclusive right turn lane from eastbound Lake Worth Road into the Mid-County Senior Center, installing new seven-foot bike lanes with upgraded safety features, milling and resurfacing Lake Worth Road in both directions, replacing underground Palm Beach County utilities throughout the project limits, improving sidewalk and driveways on both sides of Lake Worth Road, modifying medians to improve motorist safety, improving signalized intersections and pedestrian crossings, and installing new signage, pavement markings, and lighting.

Cost/Completion: \$14 million. Completion is expected in winter 2024.

Traffic Impacts:

- The outside southbound lane on Military Trail from Bowman Street to Landar Drive may be closed from 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday for directional bore operations.
- The outside northbound lane on Military Trail from Childs Street to Charlotte Street may be closed from 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday for directional bore operations.
- One southbound lane on Kirk Road from north of Lake Worth Road to south of Lake Worth Road may be closed from 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, for directional bore operations.
- One northbound lane on Kirk Road from south of Lake Worth Road to north of Lake Worth Road may be closed from 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, for directional bore operations.
- One southbound lane on Davis Road from 2nd Ave. N. to Lake Worth Road may be closed from 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, for directional bore operations.
- One northbound lane on Davis Road from Joshua Tree Street to Lake Worth Road may be closed from 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday for directional bore operations.
- The outside southbound lane on Congress Avenue from 2nd Avenue N. to Palm Beach State College Entrance may be closed from 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday for directional bore operations.
- The outside northbound lane on Congress Avenue from Palm Beach State College Entrance to 2nd Avenue N. may be closed from 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday for directional bore operations.
- Two eastbound lanes on Lake Worth Road from Raulerson Drive to Congress Avenue may be closed from 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, for drainage installation and median construction.
- Two westbound lanes on Lake Worth Road from Congress Avenue to Raulerson Drive may be closed from 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, for drainage installation and median construction. 11. 6th Avenue South Improvements at SR 9/I-95

Description: This 1-mile project in the City of Lake Worth Beach will begin Oct. 2. Project improvements consist of lengthening the turn lanes on 6th Avenue South, adding an exclusive right turn lane to the SR 9/I-95 northbound on ramp, adding an additional right turn lane to the SR 9/I-95 southbound on ramp, lengthening the northbound left turn lane at A Street, constructing 6-foot sidewalks on both sides of 6th Avenue South, constructing 7-foot bicycle lanes on both sides of 6th Avenue South, installing Wrong-Way Driving Countermeasures on the SR 9/I-95 northbound and southbound exit ramps, constructing 16-foot ground-mounted sound walls along the SR 9/I-95 northbound exit ramp and south side of 6th Avenue South, constructing new gravity wall, curb and gutter, traffic separator, median barrier, sidewalk and driveway along 6th Avenue South within project limits, upgrading drainage, signage, lighting, signalization and pavement markings, Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) upgrades, and relocation of water, sewer and utilities for the City of Lake Worth Beach.

11. Southern Boulevard (SR 80) Bridges Replacement Project

Description: This 0.76-mile project includes replacing the existing bascule (draw) bridge and tide relief bridge over the Intracoastal Waterway (ICWW) and Lake Worth Lagoon between the Town of Palm Beach and the City of West Palm Beach. The project limits are between Washington Road in West Palm Beach and State Road A1A/South Ocean Boulevard in Palm Beach. New decorative lighting, pedestrian features, traffic signals, signage and drainage are included. Cost/Completion: \$97 million. Completion is anticipated in Fall 2023.

Traffic Impact:

Marine Impact:

- The navigable waterway through the Southern Boulevard Bridge is restricted to half-channel navigation. During half-channel closures, the horizontal clearance through the bridge is 40 feet.
- The schedule of channel restrictions is published in the U.S. Coast Guard's Local Notice to Mariners at www.navcen.uscg.gov.
- The Southern Boulevard Bridge opens for marine traffic twice per hour at 15 minutes and 45 minutes past the hour.

12. SR 809/Military Trail at SR 882/Forest Hill Boulevard Intersection Improvements Project

Description: This 0.705-mile intersection improvement project on State Road 809/Military Trail and SR 882/Forest Hill Boulevard in Palm Beach County began on September 6, 2022. Work includes widening, milling, and resurfacing along SR 809/Military Trail and SR 882/Forest Hill Boulevard, constructing additional right and left turn lanes on SR 809/Military Trail and additional right turn lanes on SR 882/Forest Hill Boulevard, installing new 5-foot bike lanes at various locations along SR 882/Forest Hill Boulevard, improving sidewalks and driveways at the intersection of SR 809/Military Trail and SR 882/Forest Hill Boulevard, installing four new signal mast arms at the intersection, and installing new signage and pavement markings.
