INTERSTATES

1. **State Road (SR) 9/I-95 from south of SR 820/Hollywood Boulevard in the City of Hollywood to the south of SR 842/Broward Boulevard in the City of Fort Lauderdale and SR 862/I-595 from SR 9/I-95 to SR 7/US 441 in the Town of Davie (95 Express Phase 3C)**

Description: Work on this 9-mile 95 Express project includes extending the 699 existing Express Lanes north from just south of SR 820/Hollywood Boulevard to just south of SR 842/Broward Boulevard in Broward County. One lane will be added, and the High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) lane will be converted to create two Express Lanes in each direction. The number of general-use lanes will remain the same. Other project improvements include the construction of I-95/I-595 Direct Connectors between SR 9/95 Express Lanes and SR 862/I-595, as well as reconstruction, milling, resurfacing, and widening of SR 862/I-595 from SR 7/US 441 to SR 9/I-95 and along SR 9/I-95 from south of SR 820/Hollywood Boulevard to south of SR 842/Broward Boulevard. Additional work includes bridge widening along SR 9/I-95 at several locations, painting of 17 bridges within project limits, SR 9/I-95/SR 84 interchange modifications, Integrated Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) installation, including cameras, detectors, and dynamic message signs to optimize traffic operations, tolling/gantry construction, ramp signalization implementation at the interchanges, lighting, signage and drainage installation and construction of shoulder-mounted sound walls and retaining walls. New Traffic Patterns:

- **Traffic Pattern for SR 862/I-595 Westbound to Florida's Turnpike and SR 84 Ramp** The SR 862/I-595 westbound ramp to SR 91/Florida's Turnpike and SR 84 (Exit 8) and the ramp to US 441/SR 7 (Exit 9A-B) are now permanently separated into two ramps. The newly constructed SR 862/I-595 westbound ramp to SR 91/Florida's Turnpike and SR 84 (Exit 8) is located slightly west of the previous location and is open to drivers. Exit 9A-B continues to serve drivers traveling to US 441/SR 7. Signage is in place to assist motorists.

Traffic Impacts: Full Closures on SR 9/I-95 and SR 862/I-595 Mainline
SR 9/I-95 Traffic Impacts:

- SR 9/I-95 in each direction, between SR 820/Hollywood Boulevard and SR 736/Davie Boulevard, may have up to three lanes closed, nightly as needed, 9 p.m. until 5:30 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. The first lane will close at 9 p.m., the second lane will close at 9:30 p.m., and the third lane will close at 10:30 p.m. and reopen at 5 a.m. All lanes will be open by 5:30 a.m.
- SR 9/I-95 in each direction, from SR 820/Hollywood Boulevard to south of SR 736/Davie Boulevard, will have shoulder closures, daily and nightly, as needed, Sunday through Thursday.
- The SR 9/I-95 northbound managed lanes egress has been relocated to just south of SR 848/Stirling Road. This condition is expected to be in place through Spring 2025.
- The SR 9/I-95 northbound and southbound managed lanes and the inside general-purpose lane from Ives Dairy Road to SR 822/Sheridan Street may be closed nightly from 9 p.m. until 6 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for paving operations. FHP will be onsite to assist motorists.
- The SR 9/I-95 northbound managed lanes egress will be relocated to just south of SR 820/Hollywood Boulevard through Spring 2025 for roadway widening operations.
- The SR 9/I-95 southbound managed lanes were reduced to one lane at SR 848/Stirling Road to accommodate roadway widening operations.

SR 9/I-95 Ramp Impacts:

- **Advanced Notice:** The SR 9/I-95 southbound entrance ramp from Davie Boulevard will be closed to traffic nightly, 10:30 p.m. until 5 a.m. Monday, April 17 and Sunday, April 20 for overhead sign structure installation. Traffic will be detoured via westbound SR 736/Davie Boulevard, northbound Riverland Road, and eastbound SR 842/Broward Boulevard to access the SR 9/I-95 southbound entrance ramp. Motorists traveling eastbound on SR 736/Davie Boulevard who wish to access the SR 9/I-95 southbound entrance ramp will be directed to make a U-turn at the SR 9/I-95 overpass and follow the detour route through Riverland Road. Monday night, April 21, through Thursday night, April 24, will be used as contingency nights if needed. FHP will be onsite, and signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 9/I-95 northbound exit ramp to SR 820/Hollywood Boulevard will be closed to traffic nightly as needed, 10:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for ITS pole installation and bore operations. Traffic will be detoured via SR 822/Sheridan Street, SR 811/North Dixie Highway, and SR 820/Hollywood Boulevard. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 9/I-95 northbound to SR 862/I-595 eastbound and westbound ramp will be closed to traffic nightly, as needed, 9 p.m. until 6 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for structural steel placement operations. Traffic will be detoured via SR 818/Griffin Road and SR 7/US 441 to the SR 862/I-595 entrance ramps. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 9/I-95 northbound to the SR 862/I-595 westbound ramp will be closed to traffic nightly, as needed, 9 p.m. until 6 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for structural steel placement operations. Traffic will be detoured via Griffin Road, and SR 7/ US 441 to the SR 862/I-595 westbound entrance ramp. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 9/I-95 southbound to SR 862/I-595 eastbound ramp will be closed to traffic nightly, as needed, 9 p.m. until 6 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for superstructure construction operations. Traffic will be detoured via westbound I-595, and SR 7/US 441 to the I-595 eastbound entrance ramp. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 9/I-95 southbound to SR 862/I-595 westbound ramp will be closed to traffic nightly, as needed, 10 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for shoulder work operations. Traffic will be detoured via eastbound SR 862/I-595, SR 5/US 1, and SR 84 to the SR 862/I-595 westbound entrance ramp. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 9/I-95 southbound to the SR 862/I-595 eastbound and westbound ramp will be closed to traffic nightly as needed, 10:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for bridge construction operations. Traffic will be detoured via southbound SR 9/I-95 and SR 84 to the SR 862/I-595 entrance ramps. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 9/I-95 northbound exit ramp to SR 84 will be closed to traffic nightly, as needed 10:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via SR 9/I-95 northbound to SR 862/I-595 eastbound ramp, and SR 5/US 1 to SR 84. FHP will be onsite to assist motorists.

- The SR 9/I-95 southbound exit ramp to westbound SR 84 will be closed to traffic nightly, as needed, 10:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for traffic shift operations. Traffic will be detoured via southbound SR 9/I-95, SR 818/Griffin Road, and SR 7/US 441 to SR 84. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 9/I-95 southbound exit ramp to SR 818/Griffin Road will be closed to traffic nightly, as needed, 10 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for drainage operations. Traffic will be detoured via SR 9/I-95 southbound, SR 848/Stirling Road, and Anglers Avenue to SR 818/Griffin Road. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 9/I-95 northbound exit ramp to SR 818/Griffin Road will be closed to traffic nightly, as needed, 10:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for drilled shaft installation operations. Traffic will be detoured via SR 9/I-95 northbound, SR 862/I-595, SR 5/US 1, and SR 818/Griffin Road. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 9/I-95 northbound entrance ramp from SR 818/Griffin Road will be closed to traffic nightly, as needed, 10:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for paving operations. Traffic will be detoured via eastbound SR 818/Griffin Road, SR 5/US 1, and SR 862/I-595 to the SR 9/I-95 northbound entrance ramp. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 9/I-95 southbound entrance ramp from SR 818/Griffin Road will be closed to traffic nightly, as needed, 10 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for mainline traffic shift operations. Motorists traveling eastbound on SR 818/Griffin Road will be detoured via eastbound SR 818/Griffin Road, SR 5/US 1, and SR 848/Stirling Road to the SR 9/I-95 southbound entrance ramp. Motorists traveling westbound Griffin Road will be detoured via Anglers Avenue, and SR 848/Stirling Road to the SR 9/I-95 southbound entrance ramp. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 9/I-95 northbound exit ramp to SR 848/Stirling Road will be closed to traffic nightly, as needed, from 10:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for paving operations. Traffic will be detoured via SR 818/Griffin Road, SR 5/US 1, and SR 848/Stirling Road. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 9/I-95 northbound entrance ramp from SR 848/Stirling Road will be closed to traffic nightly, as needed 10:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for overhead sign structure installation and paving operations. Motorists traveling westbound SR 848/Stirling Road will be detoured via Anglers Avenue, and SR 818/Griffin Road to the SR 9/I-95 northbound entrance ramp. Motorists traveling eastbound SR 848/Stirling Road will be detoured via SR 5/US 1 and, SR 818/Griffin Road to the SR 9/I-95 northbound entrance ramp. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 9/I-95 southbound exit ramp to SR 848/Stirling Road will be closed to traffic nightly, as needed, 10:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for drilled shaft and column construction operations. Traffic will be detoured via southbound SR 9/I-95, SR 822/Sheridan Street, SR 7/US 441, and SR 848/Stirling Road. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 9/I-95 southbound entrance ramp from SR 848/Stirling Road will be closed to traffic nightly, as needed, 10:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for paving operations. Traffic will be detoured via SR 5/US 1, and SR 848/Stirling Road to the SR 9/I-95 northbound entrance ramp. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 9/I-95 northbound exit ramp to SR 822/Sheridan Street will be closed to traffic nightly as needed, 10:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for paving and directional bore operations. Traffic will be detoured via SR 9/I-95 northbound, SR 848/Stirling Road, and SR 5/US 1. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 9/I-95 northbound entrance ramp from SR 822/Sheridan Street will be closed to traffic nightly, as needed, 10:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for paving and directional bore operations. Traffic will be detoured via SR 822/Sheridan Street, SR 5/US 1, and SR 848/Stirling Road to the SR 9/I-95 northbound entrance ramp. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 9/I-95 northbound entrance ramp from SR 820/Hollywood Boulevard will be closed to traffic nightly, as needed, 10:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for ITS installation operations. Motorists traveling eastbound on SR 820/Hollywood Boulevard will be detoured via SR 811/North Dixie Highway and SR 822/Sheridan Street. Motorists traveling westbound on SR 820/Hollywood Boulevard will be detoured via North Park Road and SR 822/Sheridan Street. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 9/I-95 northbound exit ramp to SR 858/Hallandale Beach Boulevard will be closed

to traffic nightly, as needed, 10:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for drilled shaft installation operations. Traffic will be detoured via the SR 824/Pembroke Road exit ramp, S. Dixie Highway, and SR 858/Hallandale Beach Boulevard. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.

- The SR 9/I-95 northbound entrance ramp from SR 858/Hallandale Beach Boulevard will be closed to traffic nightly, as needed, 10:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for ITS apron pour and conduit tie-in operations. Traffic will be detoured via SR 858/Hallandale Beach Boulevard, SR 7/US 441, and SR 824/Pembroke Road to the SR 9/I-95 entrance ramp. Signage will be in place to help motorists.
- The SR 9/I-95 southbound exit ramp to SR 858/Hallandale Beach Boulevard will be closed to traffic nightly, as needed, 10:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for ITS installation operations. Traffic will be detoured via southbound SR 9/I-95, Ives Dairy Road, SR 7/US 441, and SR 858/Hallandale Beach Boulevard. Signage will be in place to assist motorists. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 9/I-95 northbound entrance ramp from SR 824/Pembroke Road will be closed to traffic nightly, as needed, 10:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for directional bore operations. Motorists traveling eastbound on SR 824/Pembroke Road will be detoured via SR 5/US 1 and SR 820/Hollywood Boulevard to the SR 9/I-95 northbound entrance ramp. Motorists traveling westbound will be detoured via SR 7/US 441, and SR 820/Hollywood Boulevard to the SR 9/I-95 northbound entrance ramp. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 9/I-95 northbound exit ramp to SR 824/Pembroke Road will be closed to traffic nightly as needed, 10:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for directional bore operations. Traffic will be detoured via SR 820/Hollywood Boulevard and SR 5/US 1 to SR 824/Pembroke Road. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 9/I-95 southbound entrance ramp from SR 824/Pembroke Road will be closed to traffic nightly, as needed, 10:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for ITS and bore operations. Motorists traveling westbound on SR 824/Pembroke Road will be detoured via SR 7/US 441, and SR 858/Hallandale Beach Boulevard to the SR 9/I-95 southbound entrance ramp. Motorists traveling eastbound on SR 824/Pembroke Road will be detoured via South Dixie Highway, and SR 858/Hallandale Beach Boulevard to the SR 9/I-95 southbound entrance ramp. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 9/I-95 southbound exit ramp to SR 824/Pembroke Road will be closed to traffic nightly, as needed, 10:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for drilled shaft installation operations. Traffic will be detoured via SR 858/Hallandale Beach Boulevard, SR 7/US 441, and SR 824/Pembroke Road. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 9/I-95 northbound entrance ramp from SR 862/I-595 westbound may have one lane closed nightly as needed, 9:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday.
- The SR 9/I-95 southbound entrance ramp from SR 862/I-595 westbound may have one lane closed nightly as needed, 9:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday.
- The SR 9/I-95 southbound entrance ramp from SR 862/I-595 eastbound may have one lane closed nightly as needed, 9:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday.
- The SR 9/I-95 northbound and southbound exit ramps to SR 818/Griffin Road may have two lanes closed intermittently, nightly as needed, 9:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday.
- The SR 9/I-95 northbound and southbound exit ramps to SR 848/Stirling Road may have two lanes closed intermittently, nightly as needed Sunday through Thursday.
- The SR 9/I-95 northbound and southbound entrance ramps from SR 848/Stirling Road may have one lane closed intermittently, nightly as needed, 9 p.m. until 5:30 a.m. Sunday through Thursday, beginning Sunday night, for ITS and drilled shaft operations.
- ***Please note that ramp closures will be performed as needed per nighttime construction operations; consecutive ramps will not be closed at the same time.**

SR 862/I-595 Traffic Impacts:

- SR 862/I-595 in each direction, from east of SR 7/US 441 to Anglers Avenue, may have up to three lanes closed nightly as needed, 9 p.m. until 5:30 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. The first lane will close at 9 p.m., the second lane will close at 9:30 p.m., and the third lane will close at 10:30 p.m. and reopen at 5 a.m. All lanes will be open by 5:30 a.m.
- I-595 in each direction, from SR 7/US 441 to SR 9/I-95, will have shoulder closures, daily

and nightly as needed, Sunday through Thursday.

- Eastbound SR 862/I-595 between SR 7/US 441 and SR 9/I-95 has been shifted to the inside lanes to allow for widening and bridge construction operations. This pattern is anticipated to be in place through Spring 2025.

SR 862/I-595 Ramp Impacts:

- The SR 862/I-595 exit ramp to SR 818/Griffin Road will be closed to traffic nightly, as needed, 10 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for flow fill drainage pipe operations. Traffic will be detoured via SR 9/I-95 southbound, SR 848/Stirling Road, and Anglers Avenue. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 862/I-595 eastbound to SR 9/I-95 northbound ramp will be closed to traffic nightly, as needed 9 p.m. until 6 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for Stay in Place Form installation operations. Traffic will be detoured via SR 862/I-595, SR 5/US 1, and SR 84 to the SR 9/I-95 northbound entrance ramp. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 862/I-595 westbound to SR 9/I-95 northbound entrance ramp will be closed to traffic nightly, as needed, 9 p.m. until 6 a.m. Sunday through Thursday, for drilled shaft operations. Traffic will be detoured via SR 9/I-95 southbound, and SR 818/Griffin Road to the SR 9/I-95 northbound entrance ramp. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 7/US 441 to I-595 eastbound entrance ramp will be closed to traffic nightly, as needed 10:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for overhead sign structure placement operations. Traffic will be detoured via southbound SR 7/US 441, Griffin Road, and SR 9/I-95 northbound to the SR 862/I-595 eastbound entrance ramp. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 862/I-595 westbound to SR 9/I-95 southbound ramp will be closed to traffic nightly, as needed 9 p.m. until 6 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for structural steel operations. Traffic will be detoured via westbound SR 862/I-595, SR 7/US 441, and eastbound SR 862/I-595 to the SR 9/I-95 southbound entrance ramp. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 862/I-595 eastbound ramp to SR 84 eastbound and the SR 91/ Florida's Turnpike will be closed to traffic nightly, as needed 10 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for sign structure installation operations. Motorists will be detoured via the adjacent ramp to SR 84. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 862/I-595 westbound ramp to SR 7/US 441 and the SR 91/ Florida's Turnpike will be closed nightly, as needed 10 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for paving operations. Traffic will be detoured via I-595 westbound and SR 736/Davie Boulevard to the SR 862/I-595 eastbound entrance ramp. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 862/I-595 eastbound entrance ramp from SR 7/US 441, the SR 91/ Florida's Turnpike, and SR 84 will be closed to traffic nightly as needed, 10:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Motorists will be detoured via SR 7/US 441, SR 818/Griffin Road, and SR 9/I-95. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 862/I-595 eastbound entrance ramp from SR 736/Davie Road will be closed to traffic nightly as needed, 10:30 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for overhead sign structure installation. Traffic will be detoured via SR 7/US 441 northbound, Davie Boulevard eastbound, the SR 9/I-95 southbound entrance ramp to the SR 862/I-595 eastbound entrance ramp. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 862/I-595 eastbound and westbound entrance ramp from SR 9/I-95 southbound may have two lanes closed nightly as needed, 9:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday.
- The SR 862/I-595 westbound entrance ramp from SR 9/I-95 southbound may have one lane closed nightly as needed, 9:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday.
- The SR 862/I-595 eastbound entrance ramp from SR 9/I-95 northbound may have one lane closed nightly as needed, 9:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday.
- The SR 862/I-595 westbound entrance ramp from SR 9/I-95 northbound may have one lane closed nightly as needed, 9:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday.
- The SR 862/I-595 westbound exit ramp to US 441/SR 7 and the SR 91/Florida's Turnpike will have one lane closed nightly as needed, 9 a.m. until 6 a.m., Sunday through Thursday.
- ***Please note that ramp closures will be performed as needed per nighttime construction operations; consecutive ramps will not be closed at the same time.**

SR 84 Traffic Impacts:

- The SR 84 eastbound entrance ramp from I-595 eastbound, SR 7/US 441, and the SR 91/ Florida's Turnpike, will be closed to traffic nightly, as needed 10 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday

through Thursday for structural steel overhead placement operations. Traffic will be detoured via SR 7/US 441, SR 818/Griffin Road, and SW 30th Avenue to SR 84. FHP will be onsite and signage will be in place to assist motorists.

- The SR 84 eastbound and westbound ramp to SR 9/I-95 southbound will be closed to traffic nightly, as needed, from 9 p.m. until 6 a.m., Sunday through Thursday for bridge construction and painting operations. Traffic will be detoured via SR 84 westbound, SW 30th Avenue, and SR 818/Griffin Road to the SR 9/I-95 southbound entrance ramp. FHP will be onsite and signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 9/I-95 northbound exit ramp to SR 84 will be closed to traffic nightly as needed, 9 p.m. until 6 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for bridge painting operations. Traffic will be detoured via SR 9/I-95 northbound to the SR 862/I-595 eastbound ramp and SR 5/US 1/North Federal Highway to SR 84. Signage will be placed to direct motorists.
- The SR 9/I-95 northbound exit ramp to eastbound SR 84 may be closed to traffic nightly as needed, 9 p.m. until 6 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for bridge painting operations. Traffic will be detoured via the SR 9/I-95 northbound exit ramp to SR 84 westbound, U-turn on SW 26th Avenue towards eastbound SR 84. Signage will be placed to direct motorists.
- SR 9/I-95 northbound entrance ramp from eastbound SR 84 may be closed to traffic nightly as needed, 9 p.m. until 6 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for bridge painting operations. Traffic will be detoured via SR 84 westbound, SR 7/US 441, and SR 862/I-595 eastbound to the SR 9/I-95 northbound entrance ramp. Signage will be placed to direct motorists.
- The SR 9/I-95 southbound exit ramp to SR 84 may be closed to traffic nightly as needed, 9 p.m. until 6 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for bridge painting operations. Traffic will be detoured via SR 9/I-95 southbound exit ramp to Griffin Road, and SR 7/US 441 northbound to SR 84. Signage will be placed to direct motorists.
