#### CR 510/85<sup>TH</sup> STREET WIDENING PROJECT

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) invites the community to a Virtual Public Meeting and In-Person Construction Open House regarding the CR 510/85<sup>th</sup> Street Widening Project in Indian River County. The project limits are on CR 510/85<sup>th</sup> Street from CR 512/Sebastian Boulevard to 87<sup>th</sup> Street. Indian River County, as project sponsor, requested that the FDOT design and construct this project through Resolution No. 2020-025. FDOT is pleased to assist with completing these improvements aimed to enhance the safety, resiliency, and longevity of the infrastructure for our communities. #### **PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS**

- Widening CR 510/85<sup>th</sup> Street from a two-lane undivided roadway to a four-lane divided roadway to improve safety and traffic operations.
- Installing seven-foot wide buffered bicycle lanes to increase safety.
- Constructing a six-foot wide sidewalk throughout the project limits to enhance pedestrian safety and connectivity.
- Installing new traffic signals at the existing signalized intersections along CR 510/85<sup>th</sup> Street and CR 512/Sebastian Boulevard, Mako Way, Hammerhead Way, and 87<sup>th</sup> Street to improve traffic operations.
- Constructing a new closed drainage system with a retention pond and new utility systems to improve functionality and long-term resiliency.
- Constructing a new bus transfer facility with six additional bus bays around the perimeter of the new retention pond to improve traffic flow.
- Installing signage and pavement markings to enhance safety, functionality, and traffic operations.

#### **TRAFFIC IMPACTS**

- Single-lane closures on CR 510/85<sup>th</sup> Street and CR 512/Sebastian Boulevard are permitted nightly, Sunday through Saturday, from 8:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.
- The speed limit on CR 512/Sebastian Boulevard between 900 feet east and west of the CR 510/85<sup>th</sup> Street intersection will be reduced from 45 MPH to 40 MPH during Phase 1 of construction.
- Access to and from bus stops will be maintained.
- The existing bus hub will remain in place and operational until the new bus hub and pond are constructed and opened for use.
- Residential and business access will be maintained.


