DAILY FULL CLOSURE OF DELAND AVENUE AT S.R. 607/EMERSON AVENUE EXTENDED THROUGH NOV. 14, 2025

To ensure community and public safety as we work to enhance the roadway and provide a safer and more resilient infrastructure, Deland Avenue at S.R. 607/Emerson Avenue may be closed daily, 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, through Friday, Nov. 14, 2025, for guardrail installation. Monday, Nov. 17 through Friday, Nov. 21 will be used as contingency dates if needed.

- **Northbound** S.R. 607/Emerson Avenue to Deland Avenue motorists will be detoured via eastbound Lakeland Boulevard to south on Lilyan Parkway to Deland Avenue.
- **Southbound** S.R. 607/Emerson Avenue to Deland Avenue motorists will be detoured via eastbound Hibiscus Road to northbound Lee Boulevard to Deland Avenue.
- Access to local residences on Deland Avenue will be maintained.
