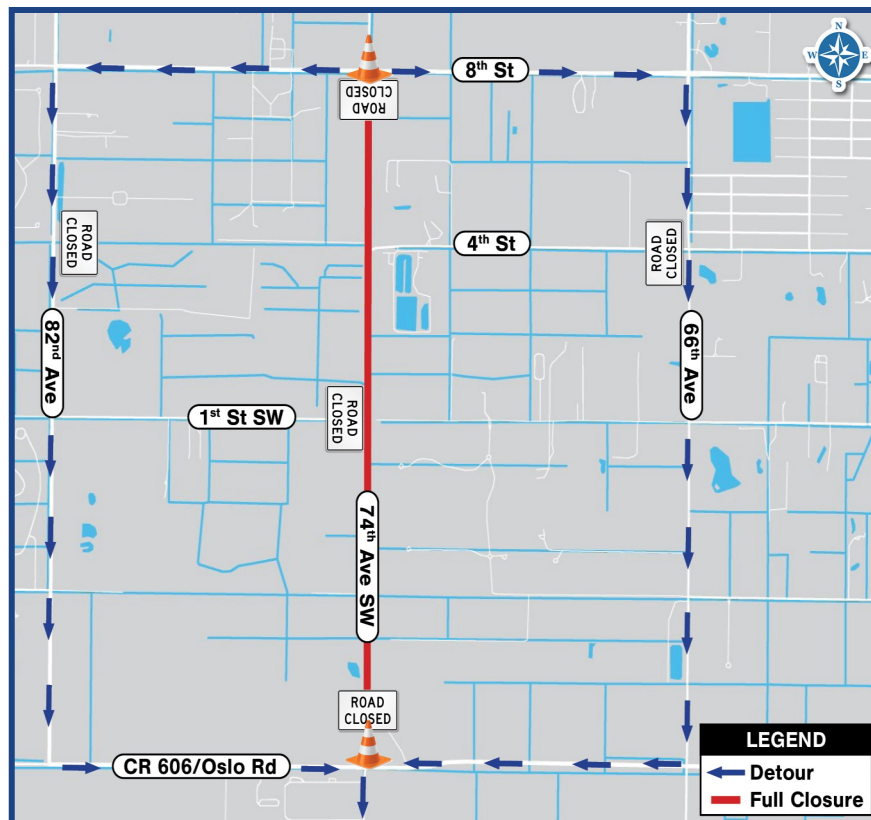
NORTHBOUND AND SOUTHBOUND 74TH AVENUE SW CLOSED FOR ROADWAY WORK THROUGH APRIL 30, 2025

Construction Cost: \$95.78 million

Construction Start: August 2023

Estimated Completion: Summer 2028

- As part of the SR 9/I-95 at County Road (CR) 606/Oslo Road New Interchange and CR 606/Oslo Road Widening Project, crews will implement the full closure of 74th Avenue SW between CR 606/ Oslo Road and 8th Street, 6 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday, Feb. 10 through Wednesday, April 30, for roadway work. If weather or unforeseen circumstances arise, 74th Avenue SW will reopen by Monday, May 5.
- Northbound** motorists will be detoured via westbound CR 606/ Oslo Road to northbound 82nd Avenue to eastbound 8th Street to 74th Avenue SW, or eastbound CR 606/ Oslo Road to northbound 66th Avenue SW to westbound 8th Street to 74th Avenue SW.
- Southbound** motorists will be detoured via westbound 8th Street to southbound 82nd Avenue to eastbound CR 606/ Oslo Road, or eastbound 8th Street to southbound 66th Avenue SW to westbound CR 606/ Oslo Road. To 74th Avenue SW.
- Access to local residences and businesses on 4th Street will be maintained.
