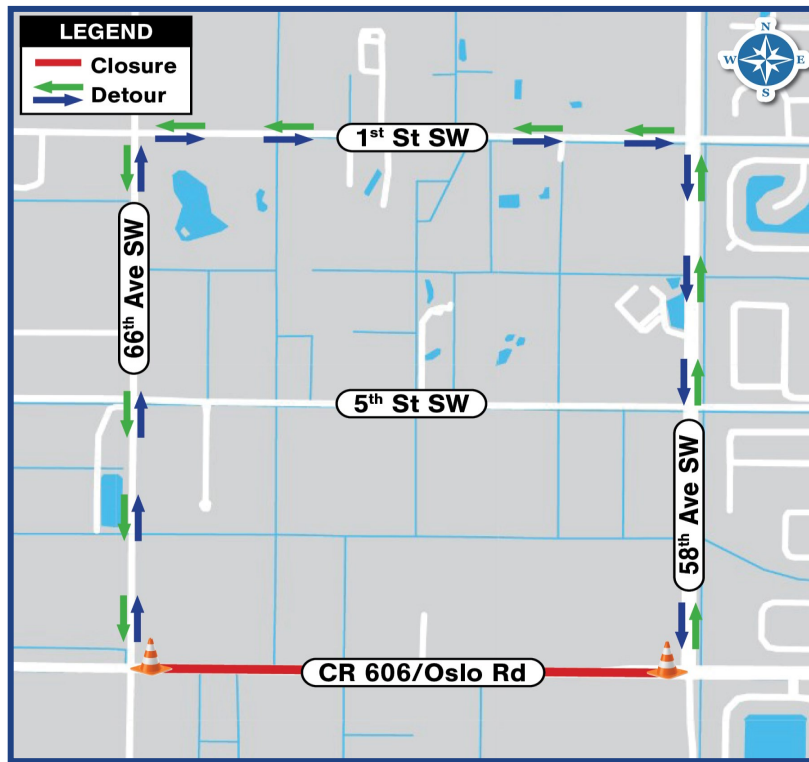

NIGHTLY CLOSURE OF CR 606/OSLO ROAD BETWEEN 66TH AVENUE SW AND 58TH AVENUE SW BEGINS AUGUST 3, 2025

Beginning on Sunday, August 3, 2025, eastbound and westbound traffic on CR 606/Oslo Road between 66th Avenue SW and 58th Avenue SW, will be closed nightly, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, until 6 a.m. Tuesday, September 30, 2025, for drainage work. If weather or unforeseen circumstances occur, CR 606/Oslo Road between 66th Avenue SW and 58th Avenue SW will be reopened to the public by Friday, October 3, 2025.

- Westbound CR 606/Oslo Road motorists will be detoured via 58th Avenue SW, 1st Street SW and 66th Avenue SW to CR 606/Oslo Road.
- Eastbound CR 606/Oslo Road motorists will be detoured via 66th Avenue SW, 1st Street SW and 58th Avenue SW to CR 606/Oslo Road.
