NORTHBOUND CR 605/OLD DIXIE HIGHWAY AT SR A1A NIGHTTIME CLOSURES BEGIN AUGUST 17, 2025

Northbound CR 605/Old Dixie Highway at SR A1A will be closed nightly, from 10 p.m. through 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, beginning Sunday, August 17, 2025, through Thursday, October 9, 2025, for bridge foundation construction. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.

- Westbound SR A1A to southbound SR 5/US 1 motorists will be detoured via southbound CR 605/Old Dixie Highway, westbound Sunny Lane, northbound SR 5/US 1, and make a U-Turn at SR A1A and SR 5/US 1 intersection onto southbound SR 5/US 1.
- Westbound SR A1A to northbound SR 5/US 1 motorists will be detoured via southbound CR 605/Old Dixie Highway and westbound Sunny Lane to northbound SR 5/US 1.
- SR A1A between SR 5/US 1 and CR 605/Old Dixie Highway was closed on September 10, 2024, for roadway and bridge construction and is anticipated to reopen in late 2026. SR 5/US 1 to eastbound SR A1A motorists will be detoured via eastbound Juanita Avenue and southbound on CR 605/Old Dixie Highway to eastbound SR A1A.
- Southbound CR 605/Old Dixie Highway will remain open.
- Access to residences and businesses will be maintained.
