SR A1A NORTH CAUSEWAY OVER THE ICWW BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT OUARTERLY PROGRESS REPORT

Tuesday, April 1, 2025, marks day 702 of 1,414, with 49% completed. Anticipated project completion is Late 2027. Additional information, flyers, and progress photos can be found on the project webpage.

PROGRESS: JANUARY - MARCH 2025

- Continued bridge beam installation
- Completed the majority of the concrete placements for the bridge foundation
- Poured the first concrete bridge deck at the far eastern span
- Installed the beams for the new Observation Walkway on the west side of the bridge
- Began pile driving for the East Coast Greenway Bridge near the western approach to the existing bridge
- Continued construction of the new SR A1A roadway on both sides of the bridge
- Installed drainage along the new Marina Access Drive
- Continued construction of the Mechanically Stabilized Earth (MSE) walls at the western approach of the new bridge on SR A1A between SR 5/US 1 and CR 605/Old Dixie Highway
- Completed the relocation of the Fort Pierce Utilities Authority sewer and watermain along SR A1A between SR 5/US 1 and CR 605/Old Dixie Highway on the west side of the project limits

ANTICIPATED WORK: APRIL - JUNE 2025

- Continue concrete placements at the bridge piers that support the bridge spans
- Drive piles and construct bridge footings
- Continue constructing the East Coast Greenway foundation and columns
- Continue roadway construction of the new SR A1A on both sides of the bridge
- Construct the bridge approach slab at the eastern end of the new bridge
- Complete the drainage work along the new Marina Access Road
- Continue construction of the MSE walls on the east and west ends of the bridge
- Continue setting bridge beams across the channel
