

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


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Project Limits





Project Overview

<u>Purpose:</u> This project aims to enhance pedestrian safety by adding a sixfoot wide sidewalk, including crosswalks at side streets and major driveways, along northbound SR 5/US 1 within the project limits.

Length: 0.86 miles

Contractor: Alexander Design + Build, LLC

Construction Start: May 2025

Contract Cost: \$1,015,707

Estimated Completion: Late 2025


Scope of Work Roadway and Pedestrian Improvements

Roadway and Pedestrian Improvements

- Installing a six-foot wide concrete sidewalk on the east side of SR 5/US 1 from CR 611/45th Street to south of 53rd Street to enhance safety and connectivity for pedestrians
- Constructing crosswalks at SR 5/US 1 and 47th Street to increase pedestrian safety
- Replacing drainage at various locations throughout the project limits to improve functionality and long-term resiliency
- Upgrading signage and pavement markings to boost safety, functionality, and traffic operations



Typical Section SR 5/US 1 from CR 611/45th Street to south of 53rd Street



No milling and resurfacing of the roadway will take place as part of this project. The scope of work is limited to sidewalk, drainage, and crosswalk improvements.



Traffic Impacts

Maintenance of Traffic:

- Business, pedestrian, and residential access will be maintained at all times throughout construction
- Single-lane closures on SR 5/US 1 are permitted as follows:
 - Daily and nightly, Monday through Friday
 - 7:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. within 600 feet of a signalized intersection, Monday through Thursday

Construction Phases

Phase 1:

- Construct the sidewalk, driveway, guardrail, and headwall extension and relocate the watermain along northbound SR 5/US 1 within the project limits
- Install crosswalks at SR 5/US 1 and 47th Street

Safety and Local Coordination

- Public Safety is our Top Priority!
 - Work Zone Signage & Maintenance of Traffic
 - Advanced warning and project signage will be placed throughout the construction corridor to alert the traveling public



- The project team will continue working closely with local stakeholders including local municipalities, schools, neighborhoods and other local agencies to ensure safety standards are met and impacts to the public are minimized in any way possible
- Emergency vehicles will be provided access at all times
