SW PORT ST. LUCIE BOULEVARD WIDENING PROJECT MONTHLY PROGRESS REPORT

As of Tuesday, July 1, 2025, the project is 87.5% complete. The anticipated project completion is Late Summer 2025. Additional information, flyers, and progress photos can be found on the <u>project webpage</u>.

PROGRESS: JUNE 2025

- Completed construction of the new pond and continued placing sod
- Continued subgrade work and curb pad installation for the new northbound travel lanes
- Completed roadway reconstruction activities and reopened SW Tulip Boulevard and SW Tunis Avenue and continued reconstruction work at SW Thrift Avenue
- Closed SW Trouville Avenue and SW Rice Avenue for roadway reconstruction activities
- Continued excavation work for the new northbound SW Port St. Lucie Boulevard travel lanes and began placing the second lift of base rock throughout the project limits
- Placed asphalt for the outside median and curb pads along the southbound SW Port St. Lucie Boulevard travel lanes
- Poured the concrete for the textured median separator
- Continued installation of signal and lighting components throughout the project corridor
- Installed pedestrian pole foundations along northbound SW Port St. Lucie Boulevard
- Removed existing signage and installed new road signs along northbound SW Port St. Lucie Boulevard

ANTICIPATED WORK: JULY 2025

- Continuing subgrade work and curb pad installation for the new northbound travel lanes
- Installing textured pavement on the median traffic separator
- Continuing traffic signal work
- Finishing construction of light pole foundations along northbound SW Port St. Lucie Boulevard
- Completing roadway reconstruction on SW Thrift Avenue, SW Trouville Avenue, and SW Rice Avenue and reopen the side streets
- Finishing excavation of the new northbound SW Port St. Lucie Boulevard travel lanes and completing base rock installation
- Ongoing drainage work throughout the project limits
- Continuing installation of new signage in the median
- Ongoing concrete pours for the textured median separator
- Completing the placement of sod, seed, and mulch at the pond
