SW PORT ST. LUCIE BOULEVARD WIDENING PROJECT MONTHLY PROGRESS UPDATE

PROGRESS: SEPTEMBER 2025

- Installed the ditch liner at the S-504 outfall located on SW Port St. Lucie Boulevard approximately 100-feet north of SW Fisherman Avenue
- Began drainage pipe repairs throughout the project limits
- Completed utility valve and manhole work before roadway paving along SW Port St. Lucie Boulevard
- Began planting trees in the median
- Began cleaning and sealing the median textured concrete throughout the project limits
- Placed tree root barrier throughout the project corridor
- Continued placing final friction course asphalt along SW Port St. Lucie Boulevard and side streets
- Continued deficiency repairs throughout the project limits
- Completed light pole installation along southbound SW Port St. Lucie Boulevard
- Completed placement of final friction course asphalt along SW Port St. Lucie Boulevard and side streets

ANTICIPATED WORK: OCTOBER 2025

- Completing drainage pipe repairs
- Completing irrigation work
- Finishing landscaping throughout the project limits
- Placing final pavement markings throughout the project corridor
- Completing sign installation work
- Completing deficiency repairs
