



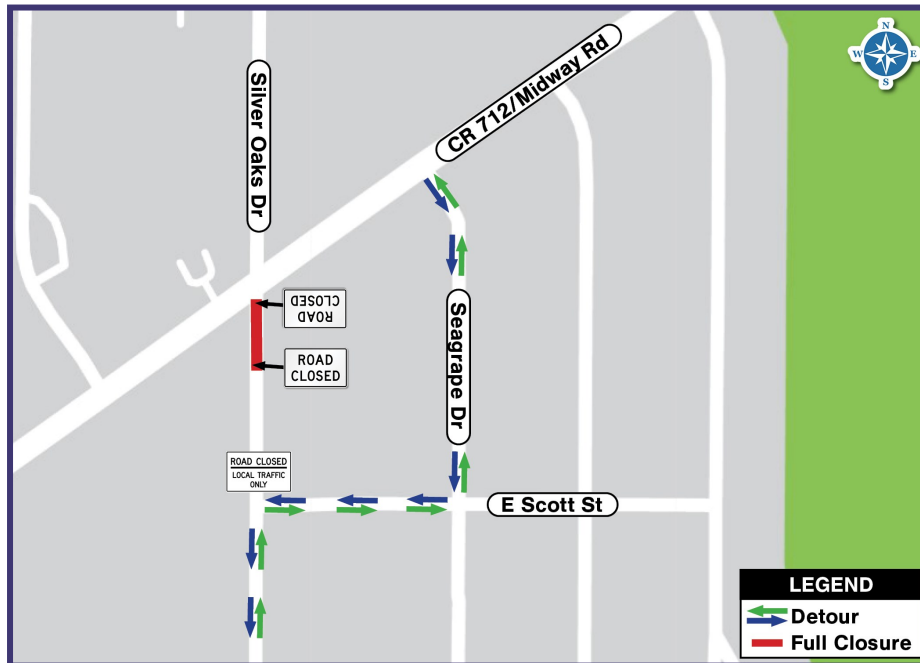

### TRAFFIC DETOUR OF SILVER OAKS DRIVE AT COUNTY ROAD (CR) 712/MIDWAY ROAD TO BEGIN ON JUNE 16

Beginning at 10 a.m. on Monday, June 16, southbound Silver Oaks Drive at CR 712/Midway Road will be closed through 4 p.m. for drainage work. Tuesday, June 17, through Friday, June 20, will be used as contingency dates if needed. Signage will be posted to assist motorists.

- Northbound Silver Oaks Drive to CR 712/Midway Road motorists will be detoured via east on East Scott Street, north on Seagrape Drive to CR 712/Midway Road.
- Southbound Silver Oaks Drive motorists from CR 712/Midway Road will be detoured via south on Seagrape Drive, west on East Scott Street to south on Silver Oaks Drive.
