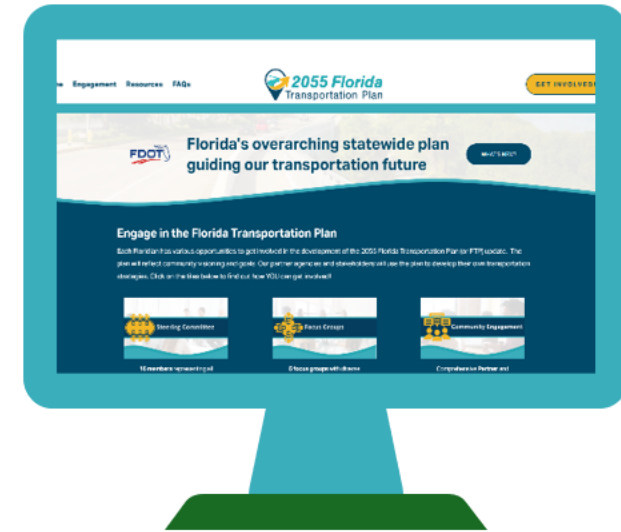
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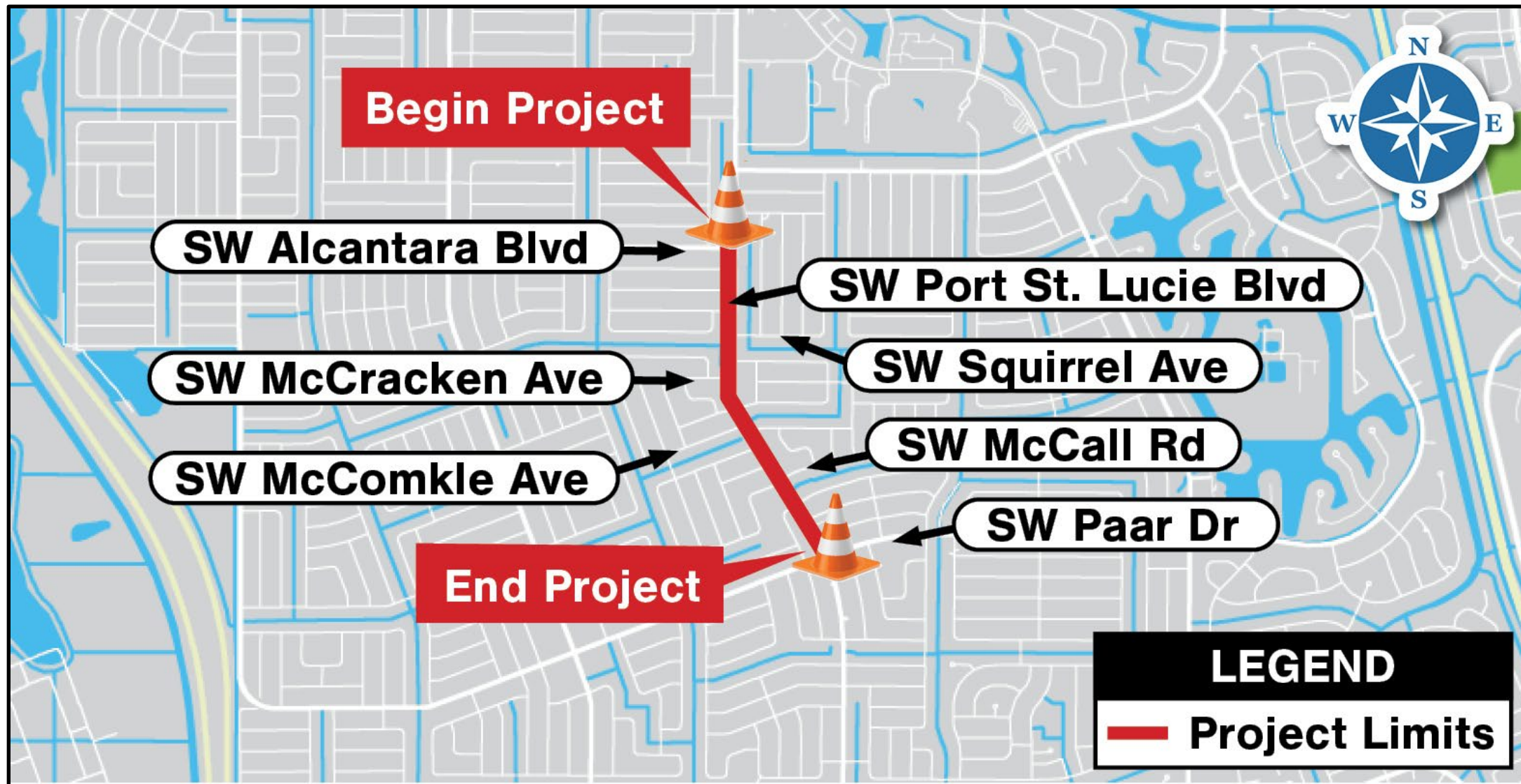
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Project Limits



Project Overview

Purpose: The project aims to enhance safety, traffic operations, and pedestrian connectivity by widening the roadway, upgrading intersections and pedestrian facilities, improving lighting and drainage, and adding new signage and pavement markings.

Length: 1.076 miles

Contractor: Roadway Construction, LLC

Construction Start: September 2025

Cost: \$25,577,357

Estimated Completion: Fall 2028

Scope of Work

Roadway Improvements

Roadway Improvements

- Widening SW Port St. Lucie Boulevard from a two-lane undivided roadway to a four-lane divided roadway, separated by an 18-foot wide median with stamped concrete and landscaping to improve safety and traffic operations.
- Constructing new right-turn lanes on SW Port St. Lucie Boulevard at the north and south approaches to SW Paar Drive to enhance traffic flow.
- Installing signage and pavement markings to improve safety, functionality, and traffic operations.

Scope of Work

Pedestrian and Motorist Safety Improvements

Pedestrian and Motorist Safety Improvements

- Constructing new signalized intersections with mast arms on SW Port St. Lucie Boulevard at SW Paar Drive and SW McCall Road to improve safety and traffic operations.
- Upgrading existing sidewalk curb ramps and constructing a new 8- to 10-foot wide sidewalk along both sides of SW Port St. Lucie Boulevard and adjacent side streets to improve pedestrian safety and connectivity.
- Upgrading the existing lighting to LED fixtures and installing new light poles on the east side of the roadway within the project limits to improve safety for motorists and pedestrians.

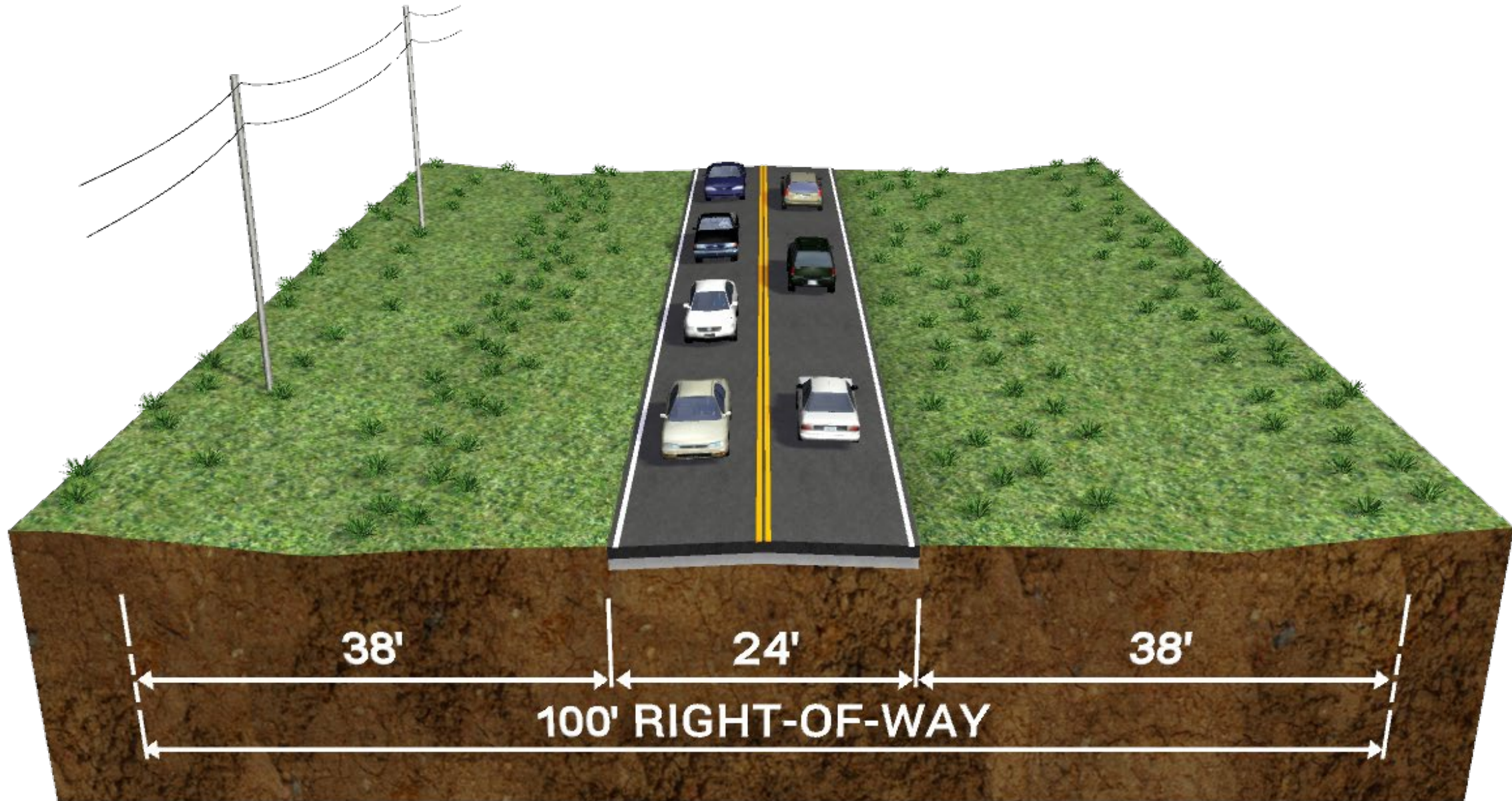

- Constructing a new drainage system to enhance functionality and long-term resiliency.

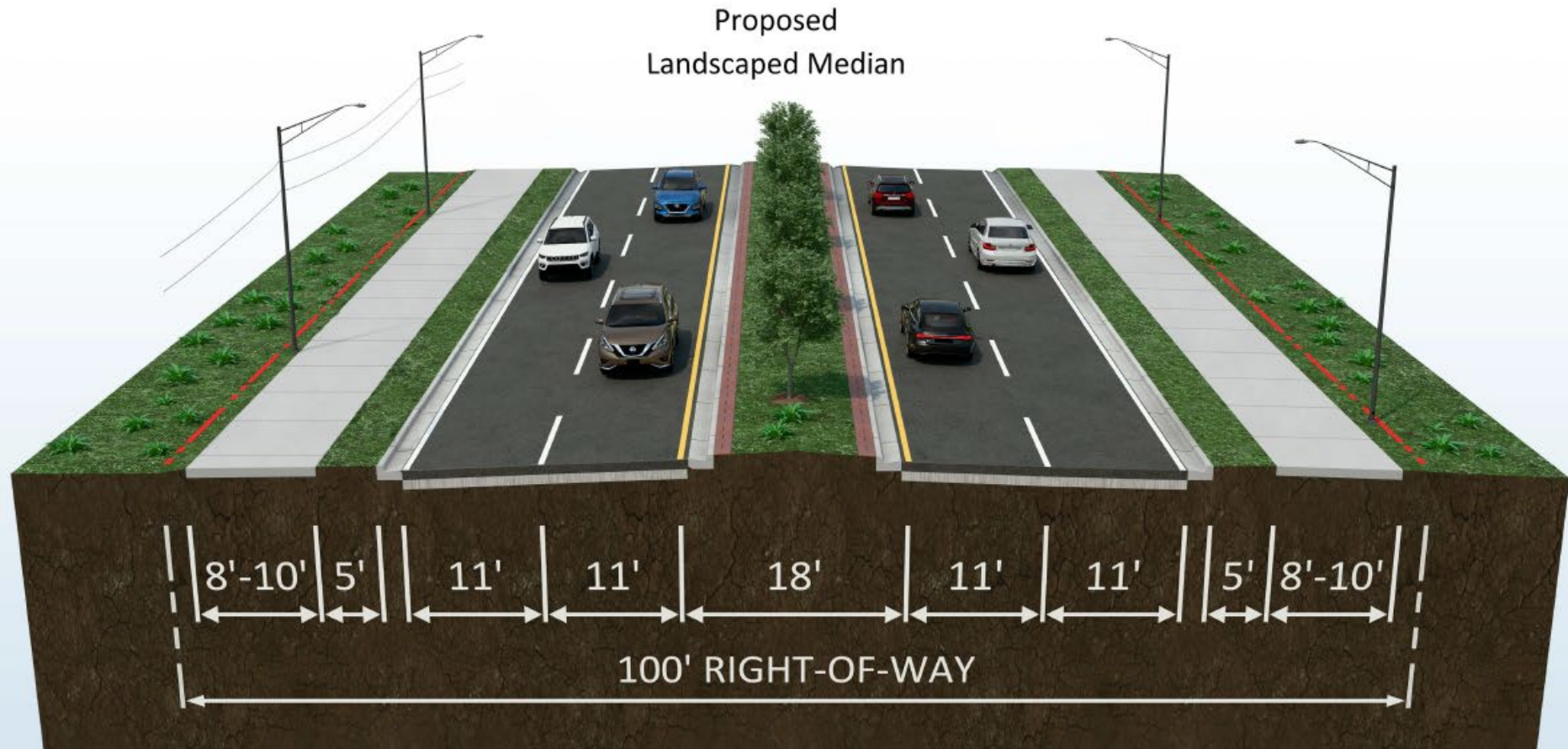


Intersection of SW Port St. Lucie Boulevard at

Maintenance of Traffic:

- Lane closures are permitted daily, Monday through Sunday, from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- Nighttime work may occur Monday through Sunday from 7:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. Advanced notice will be provided.
- Residential and business access will be maintained.

Construction Phases

Pre-Phase 1:

- Place temporary traffic control devices.
- Remove the existing striping and place temporary pavement markings.
- Shift traffic to the west onto the temporary alignment.
- Construct drainage improvements.
- Construct temporary pavement on northbound SW Port St. Lucie Boulevard for Phase 1 work activities and the median for the Phase 2 traffic shift.

Construction Phases

Phase 1:

- Place temporary traffic control devices, temporary striping, and relocate traffic signal heads before shifting traffic.
- Shift traffic to the east onto the temporary roadway alignment.
- Complete construction of the temporary drainage and construct the drainage improvements along southbound SW Port St. Lucie Boulevard.
- Construct the new southbound SW Port St. Lucie Boulevard travel lanes, lighting, and signing improvements.
- Place temporary striping onto the newly constructed southbound roadway for Phase 2 traffic shift.

Phase 2:

- Place temporary traffic control devices and erosion control devices throughout the project limits.
- Activate temporary traffic signals.
- Shift northbound and southbound traffic onto the newly constructed southbound SW Port St. Lucie Boulevard travel lanes.
- Construct the new northbound travel lanes.
- Install signage throughout the project limits.
- Construct traffic signal and lighting improvements.
- Complete drainage work along northbound SW Port St. Lucie Boulevard.

Phase 3:

- Place temporary traffic control devices.
- Complete median curb, median inlet and gutter, traffic separator, and median at side street locations.
- Mill and place structural asphalt at the northern and southern project limits.
- Place all signage, signal heads, and other signal equipment in the final layout.
- Shift traffic onto the newly constructed northbound and southbound roadway.

Construction Phases

Phase 4:

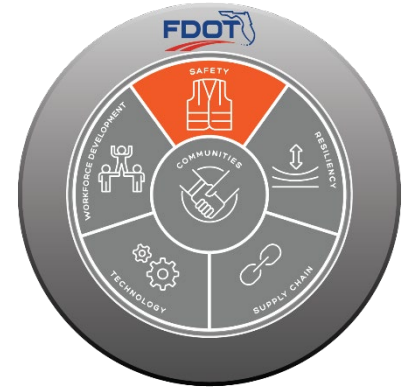
- Place landscaping, final friction course asphalt, and final pavement markings.

 - Advanced warning and project signage will be placed throughout the construction corridor to alert the traveling public

 - The project team will continue working closely with local stakeholders including local municipalities, schools, neighborhoods and other local agencies to ensure safety standards are met and impacts to the public are minimized in any way possible
 - **Emergency vehicles will be provided access at all times**

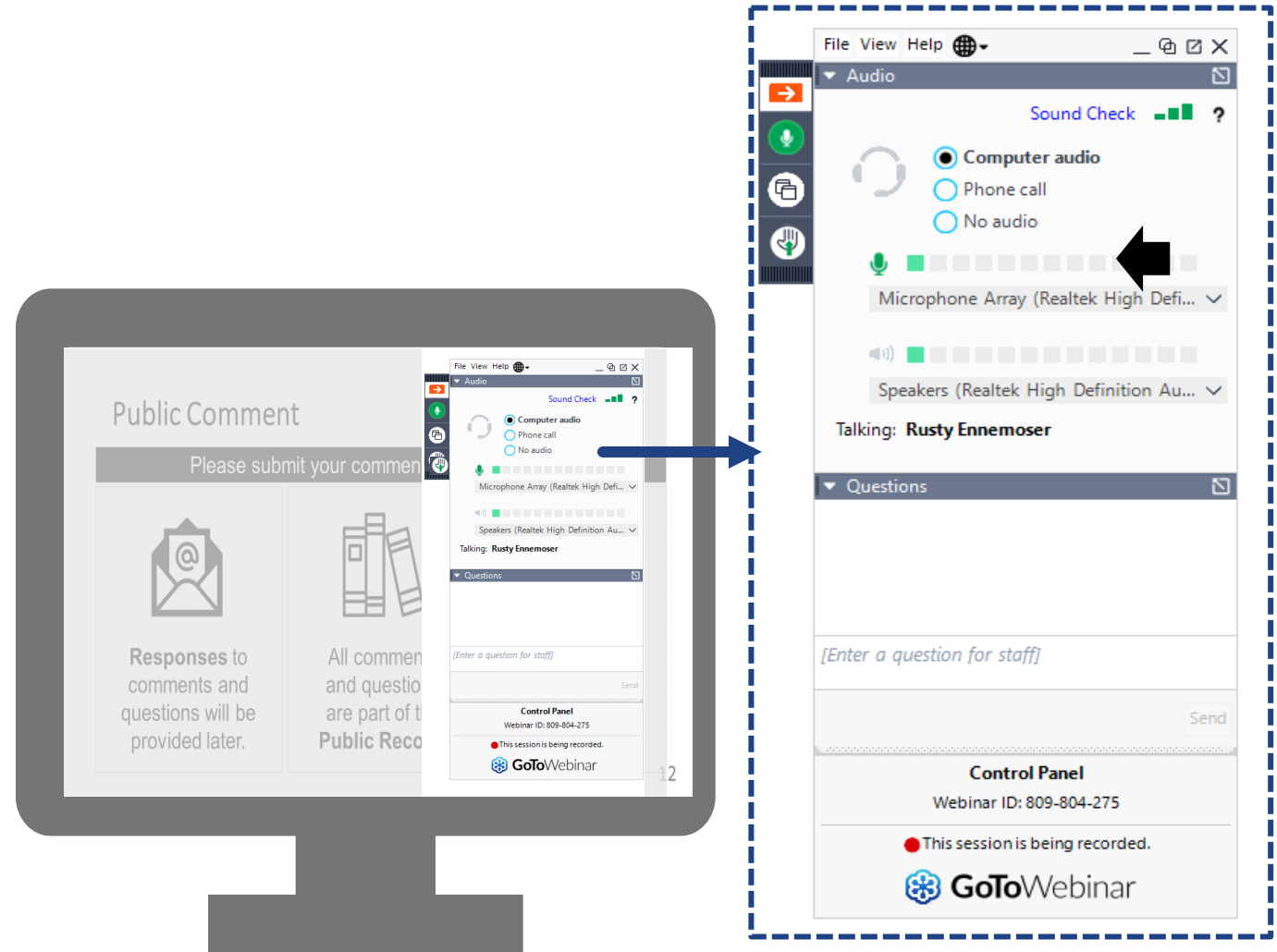


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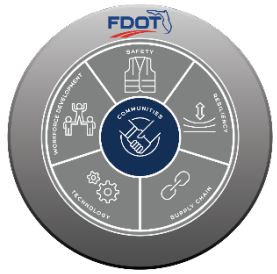
