



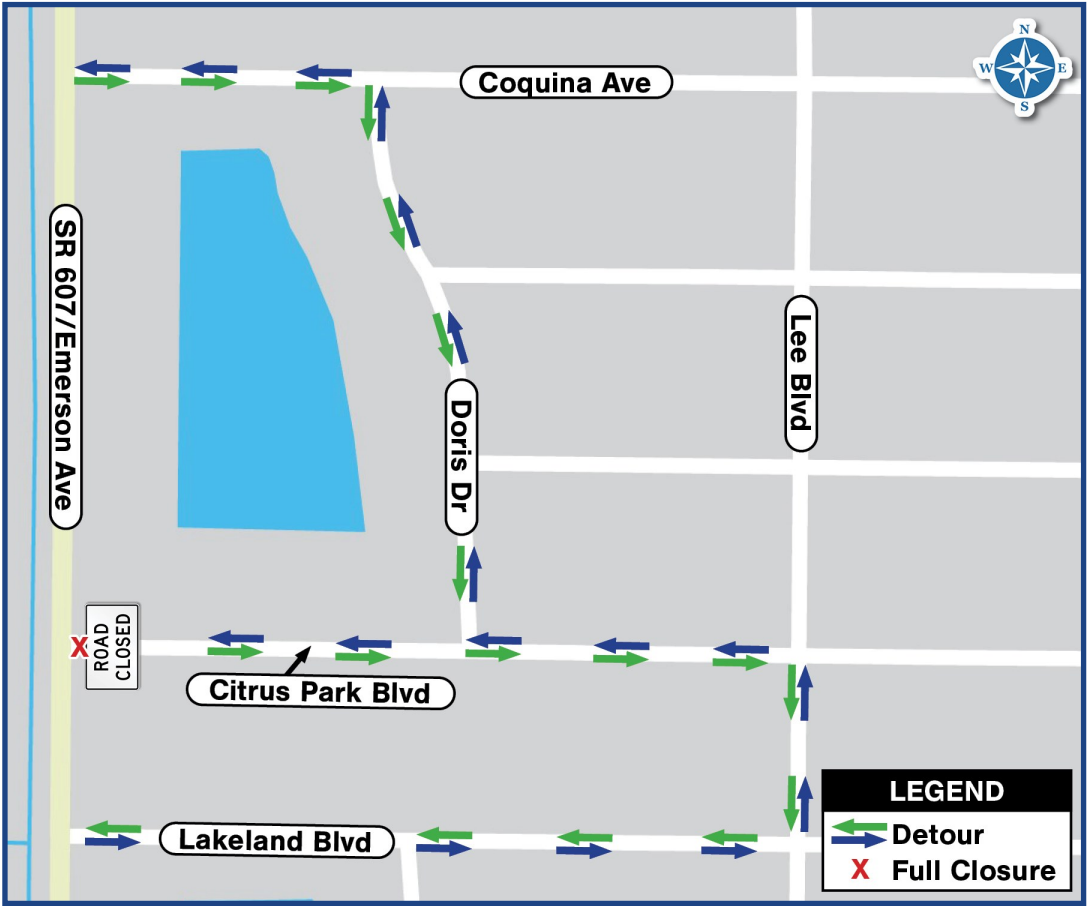

FULL CLOSURE OF CITRUS PARK BOULEVARD AT SR 607/EMERSON AVENUE EXTENDED TO MAY 13

To ensure community and crew safety as we work to enhance the roadway and provide a safer and more resilient infrastructure, Citrus Park Boulevard at SR 607/Emerson Avenue will be intermittently closed between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m., Wednesday, May 7 to Tuesday, May 13, for utility work. This closure was first implemented on April 21. Signage will be posted to assist motorists. The closure may be extended to Friday, May 16, due to weather conditions or unforeseen impacts. **Only one side street will be closed at a time.**

- **Northbound** SR 607/Emerson Avenue to Citrus Park Boulevard motorists will be detoured via eastbound Lakeland Boulevard to north on Lee Boulevard, to westbound Citrus Park Boulevard.
- **Southbound** SR 607/Emerson Avenue to Citrus Park Boulevard motorists will be detoured via eastbound Coquina Avenue to southbound Doris Drive to Citrus Park Boulevard.
- **Westbound** Citrus Park Boulevard to northbound SR 607/Emerson Avenue motorists will be detoured via eastbound Citrus Park Boulevard to northbound on Doris Drive to westbound on Coquina Avenue to SR 607/Emerson Avenue.
- **Westbound** Citrus Park Boulevard to southbound SR 607/Emerson Avenue motorists will be detoured via eastbound Citrus Park Boulevard to southbound Lee Boulevard to westbound Lakeland Boulevard to SR 607/Emerson Avenue.
- Access to local residences on Citrus Park Boulevard will be maintained.
