

## TRAFFIC DETOUR OF SILVER OAKS DRIVE AT COUNTY ROAD (CR) 712/MIDWAY ROAD TO BEGIN ON MAY 19

Beginning at 10 a.m. on Monday, May 19, southbound Silver Oaks Drive at CR 712/Midway Road will be closed from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. for drainage work. Tuesday, May 20, through Friday, May 23, will be used as contingency dates if needed. Signage will be posted to assist motorists.

- Northbound Silver Oaks Drive to CR 712/Midway Road motorists will be detoured via east on East Scott Street, and north on Seagrape Drive to CR 712/Midway Road.
- Southbound Silver Oaks Drive motorists from CR 712/Midway Road will be detoured via south on Seagrape Drive, west on East Scott Street and south onto Silver Oaks Drive.
- Eastbound and westbound CR 712/Midway Road motorists to south on Silver Oaks Drive will be detoured via south on Seagrape Drive, west on East Scott Street, and south onto Silver Oaks Drive.
- Access to local residences will be maintained.
