US 1/SR 5 Improvements Project in Martin County

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, will host a Virtual Public Meeting for the US 1/SR 5 improvements project from north of Britt Road to south of Jensen Beach Boulevard/SR 732 in Martin County. The purpose of this project is to provide a fourth continuous northbound thru/shared right-turn lane between Britt Road and Jensen Beach Boulevard.

Construction Cost: \$547,644

Construction Start: March 4, 2021

Anticipated Completion: Summer 2021

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

Work at the US 1/SR 5 and Treasure Coast Square Mall south entrance intersection includes:

- Reconstructing curb ramp and sidewalk at the northeast corner
- Widening the roadway at the northeast corner
- Removing the existing double mast arm signal pole at the northeast corner, and replacing it with new signal mast arms at the northeast and southeast corners

Additional work on this project includes:

- Restriping northbound US 1 lanes to provide a continuous thru/shared right-turn lane and bike lane
- Milling and resurfacing the existing two outside northbound lanes to accommodate restriping

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

Work will occur in phases to minimize impacts to the public. Lane closures are permitted Sunday through Thursday night from 9:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. Sidewalk closures will occur, and pedestrian will be detoured at the nearest signalized intersections.
