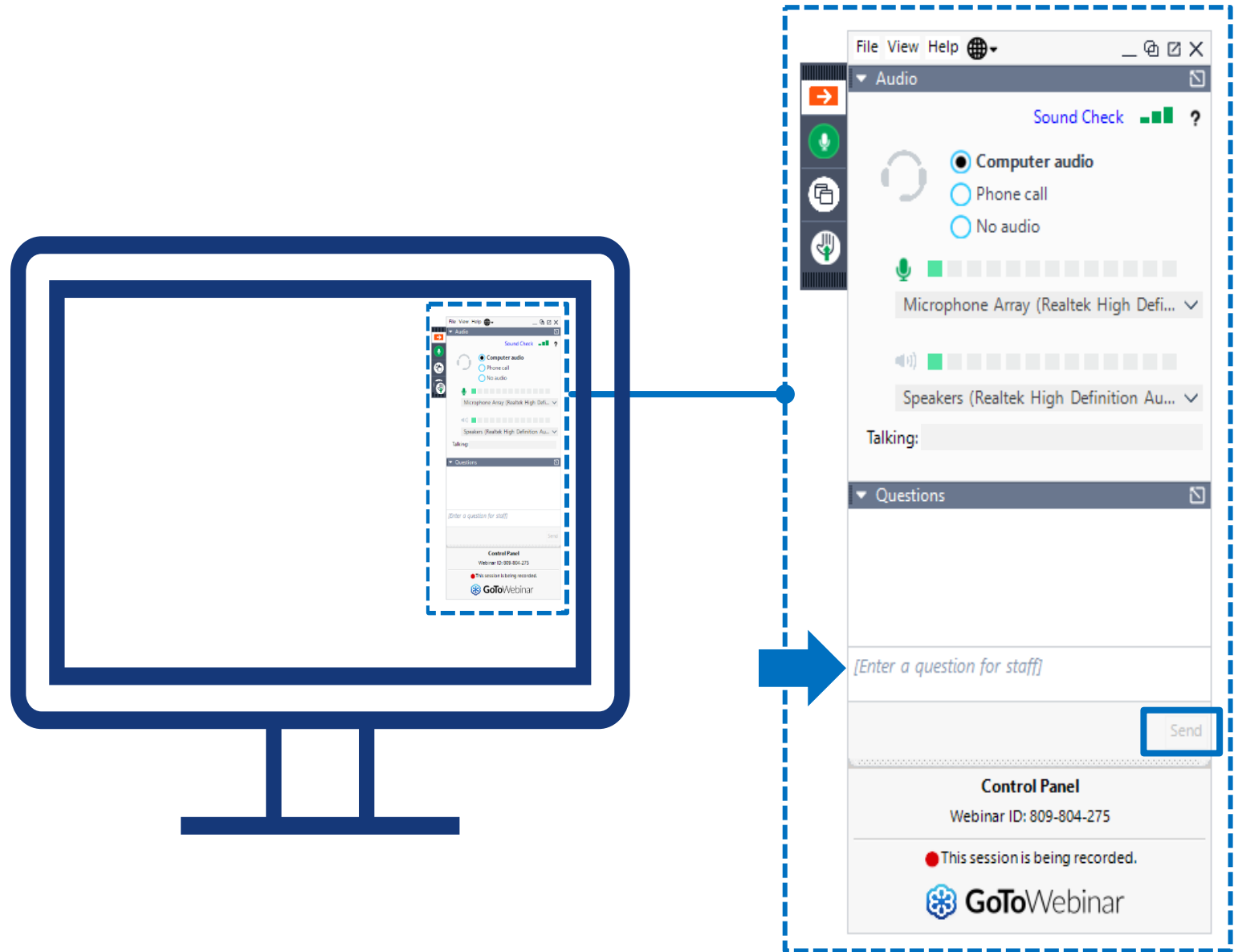

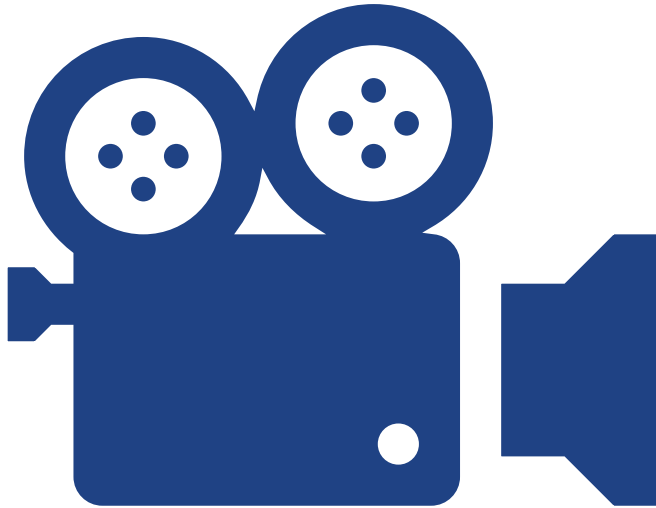

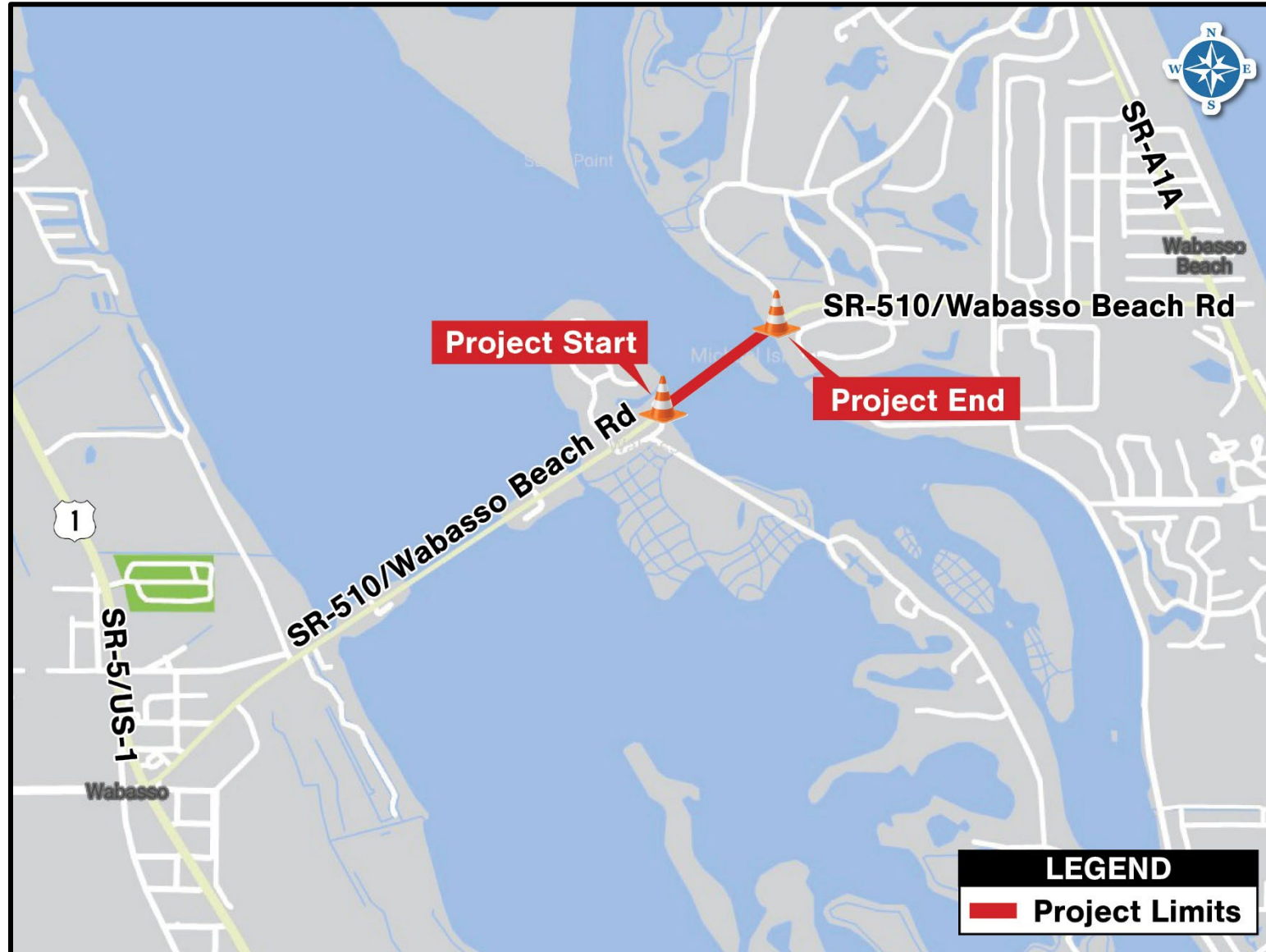

# Project Overview

**Purpose:** Install railing on the north and south sides of the existing SR-510/Wabasso Beach Road bridge.

**Length:** 0.3 miles

**Contractor:** Lambert Bros., Inc.

**Construction Start:** Late March 2023

**Estimated Contract Cost:** \$1.4 Million

**Contract Time:** 182 calendar days  
(not including weather and holidays)

**Estimated Completion:** Late Summer 2023

## Maintenance of Traffic

- Work will be done in two (2) major phases to minimize impacts to the construction corridor
- Single-lane closures are permitted nightly Sunday through Thursday, from 6:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. Daytime lane closures are not permitted.



# Traffic Impacts & Construction Phasing

## Maintenance of Traffic

- To minimize impact to the public, lane closures are not permitted on Fridays, Saturdays, holidays, or special event dates, including:
  - Vero Beach Half Marathon and Sea Turtle 2 Miler
  - Vero Beach Boat Show
  - Vero Beach Air Show
- Business and residential access will be maintained at all times

## Phase 1

### - North Side of the Bridge (Westbound Lanes)

- Install railing on the north side of the bridge

## Phase 2

### - South Side of the Bridge (Eastbound Lanes)

- Install railing on the south side of the bridge

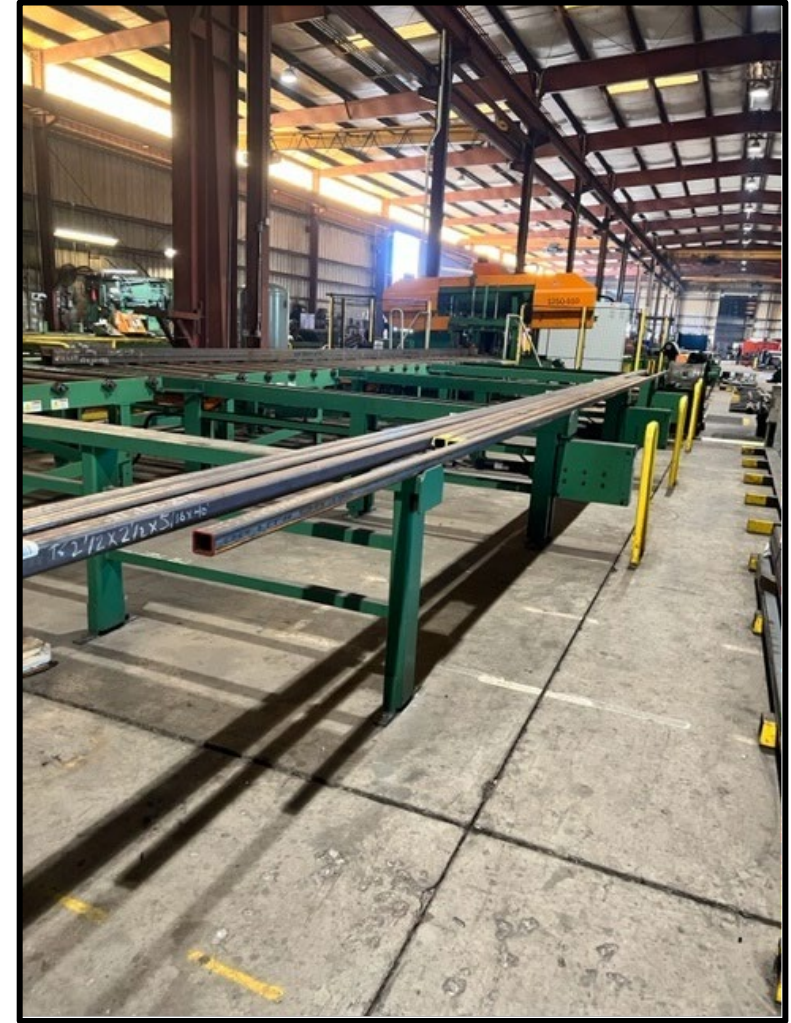

  - **Work Zone Signage & Maintenance of Traffic**
    - Advanced warning and project signage will be placed throughout the construction corridor to alert the traveling public
  - **Local Agency & Stakeholder Coordination**
    - The project team will continue working closely with local stakeholders including local municipalities, schools, neighborhoods and other local agencies to ensure safety standards are met and impacts to the public are minimized in any way possible
  - **Emergency vehicles will be provided access at all times**

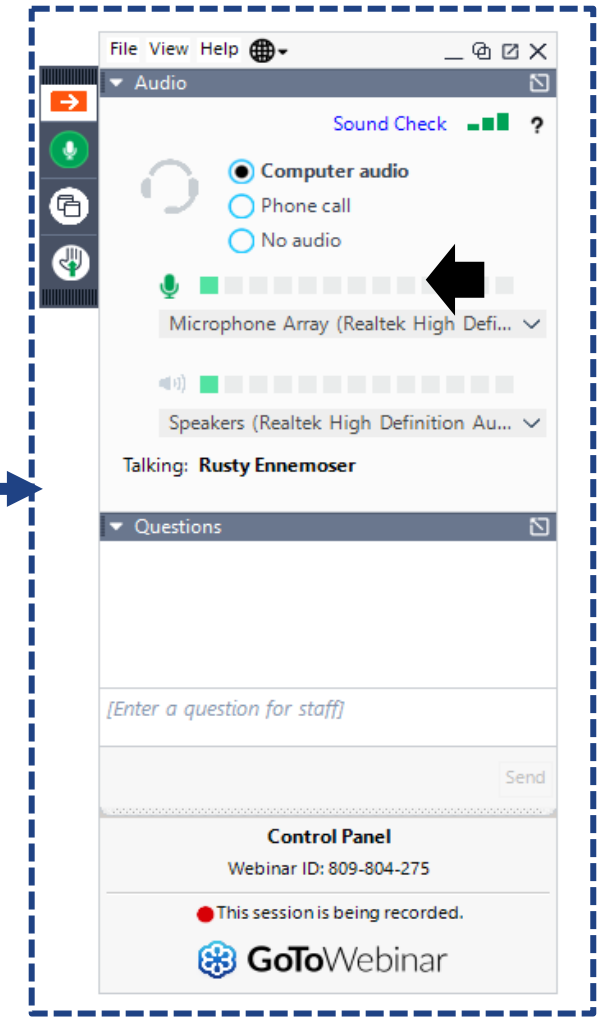
