The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, will host a Virtual Public Meeting and an In-person Construction Open House on Thursday, March 10, 2022. The Virtual Public Meeting will take place from 5:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., with the In-person Construction Open House to follow from 6:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. Please see below for detailed meeting information.

Construction Cost: \$1,436,682 Construction Start: March 19, 2022 Estimated Completion: Fall 2022

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Remove the existing deteriorated east and west seawalls (concrete caps and steel sheet piles) and replace with rubble riprap slope protection
- Repair the existing spalls in the concrete piles and concrete beams at various locations

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Work will take place during the daytime and will be sequenced to reduce the effects of construction on the community
- Work will be performed from barges within the waterway
- Temporary single lane closures may be required for up to three (3) consecutive hours at one time for the loading and un-loading of construction materials
- The channel will remain open to marine traffic for the duration of construction
- Construction will occur in phases to minimize impacts to the public; detailed lane closure information will be provided weekly in the FDOT traffic report


