Project Overview

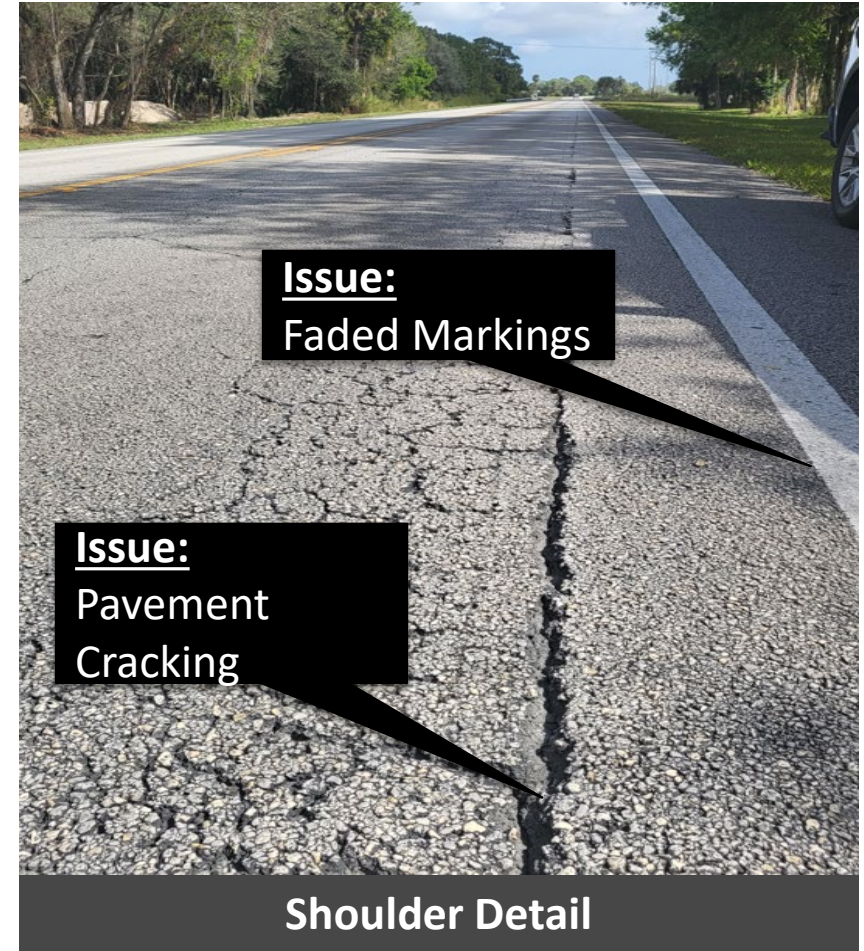
Proposed Improvements:

- Repaving and restriping the existing roadway
- Widening the existing shoulders from 4 to 7 feet paved
- Replacement of deficient signing and installation of new pavement markings
- Installation of audible/vibratory treatment (profiled thermoplastic) along the centerline and edge lines of the roadway
- Regrading the existing linear ditch in front of St. Lucie Mobile Home park
- Extending the existing guardrail at selected locations to address canal hazards
- Replacing existing TMS (traffic monitoring) loops

Project Length: 1.9 miles

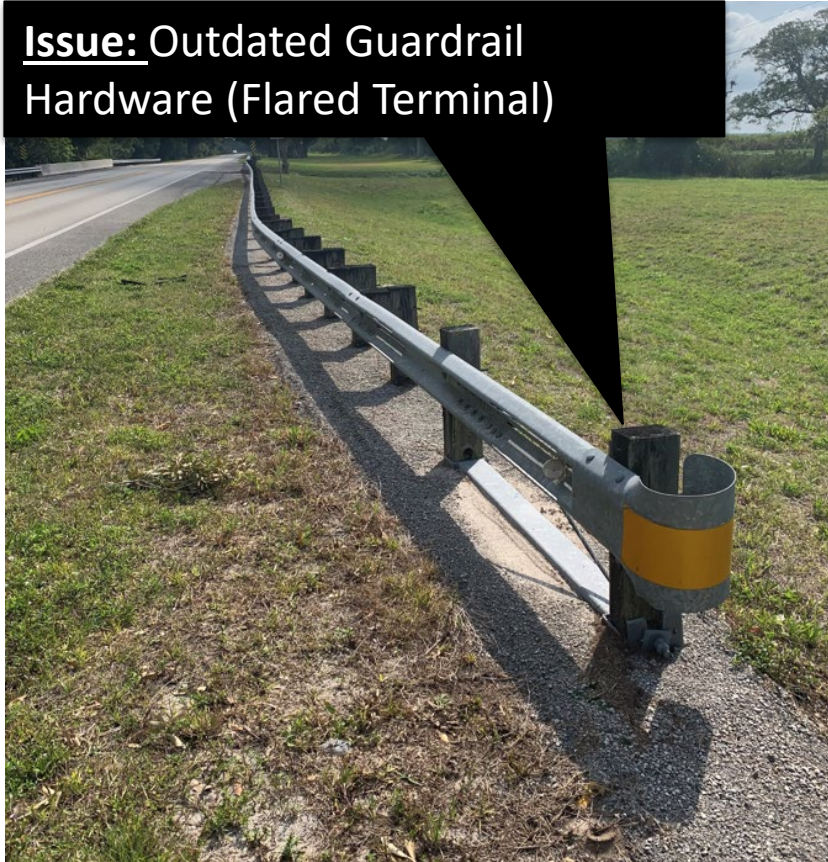

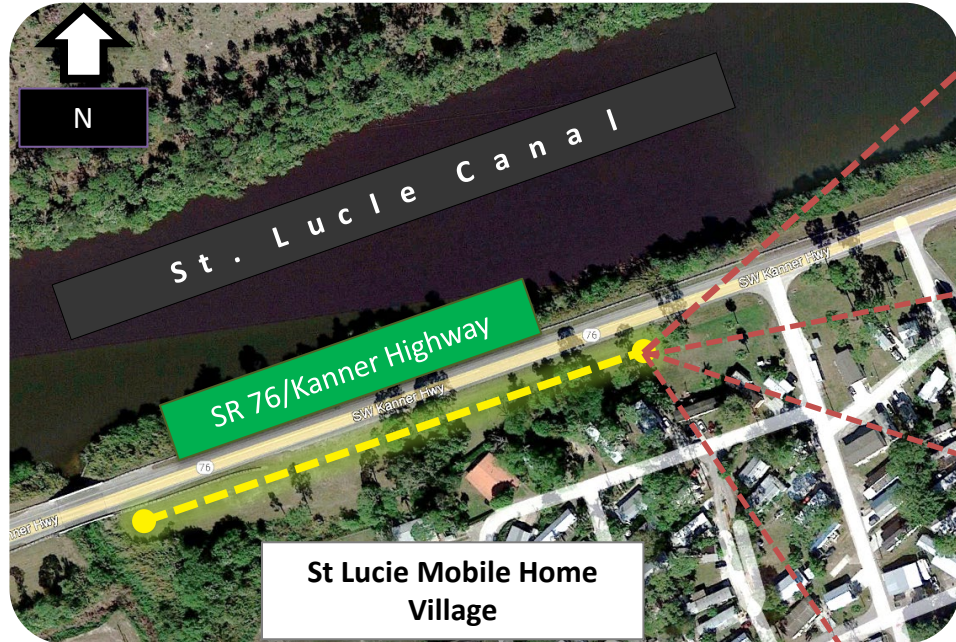

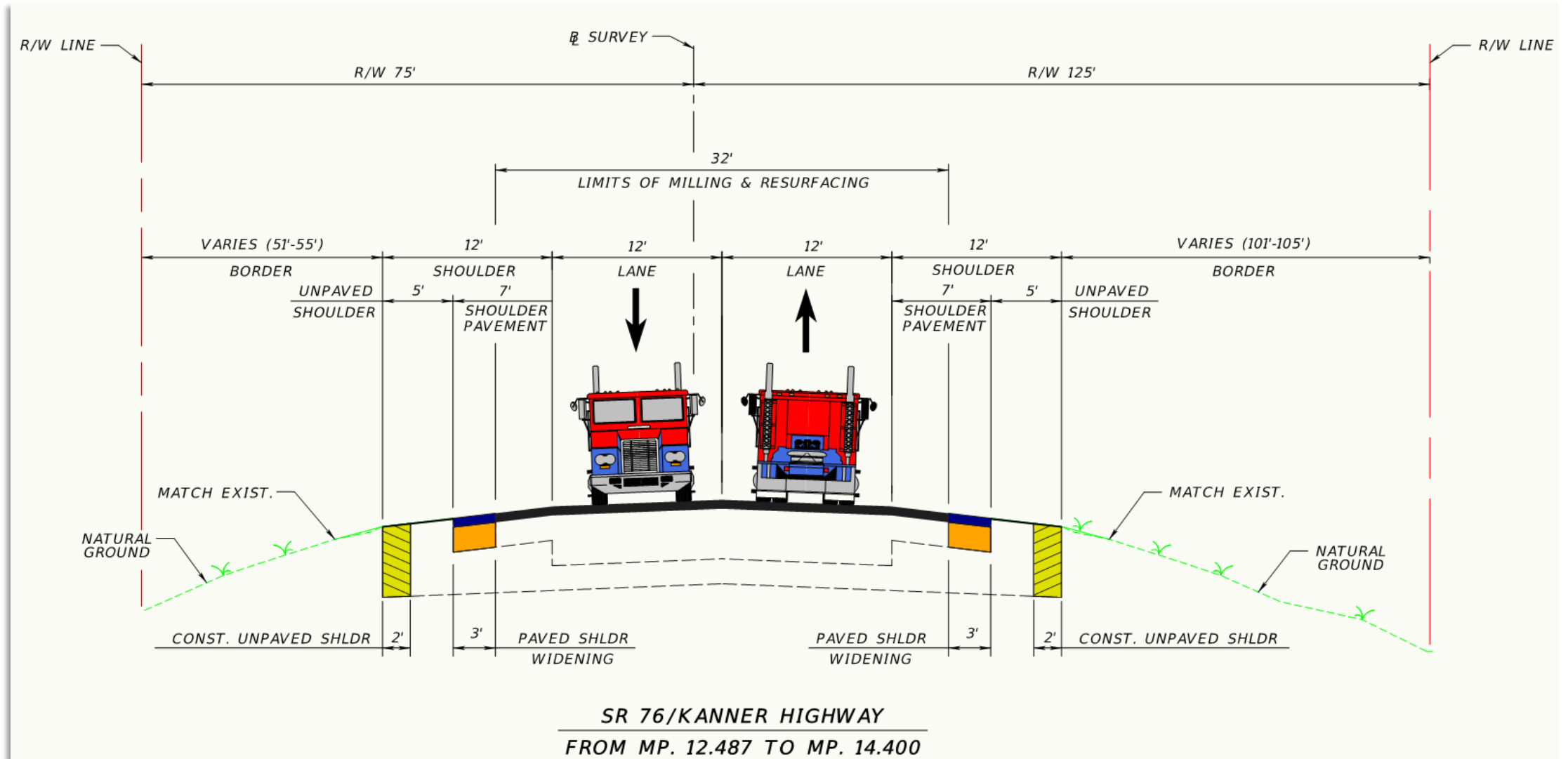

Proposed Typical Section State Road (SR) 76/Kanner Highway



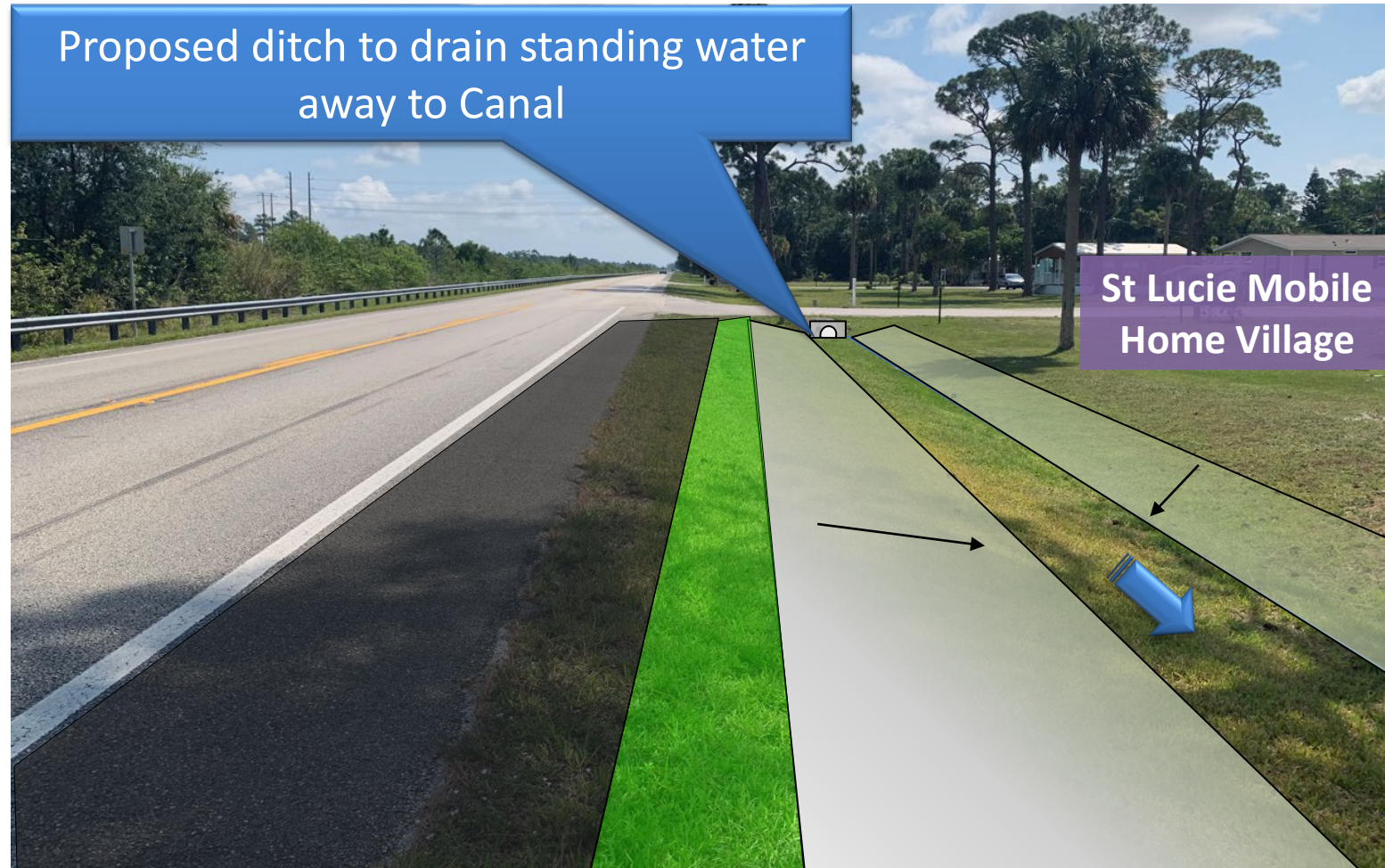

Maintenance of Traffic

Temporary Traffic Control Plan

- Work will be done in phases to reduce the effects of construction in the community
- Temporary lane closures using flaggers will be needed during off-peak hours on non-event/holiday dates
- Closed lanes will be reopened to traffic at the end of each active work period
- Access to adjacent properties will be maintained at all times

Estimated Completion: Summer 2024

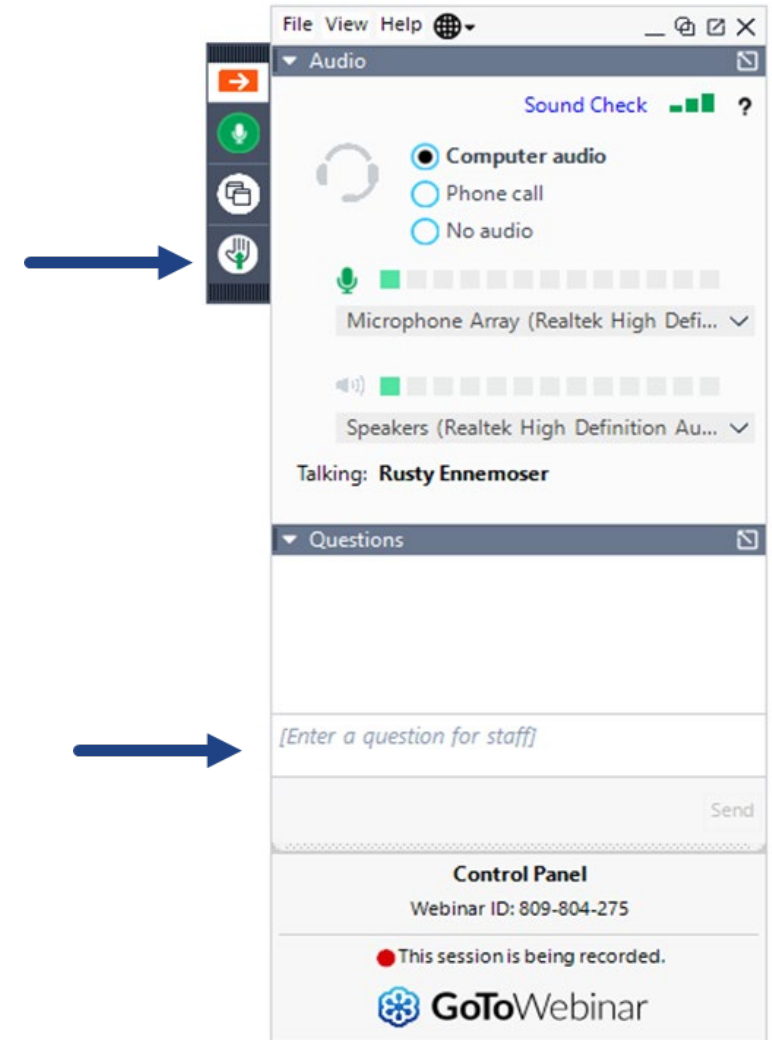

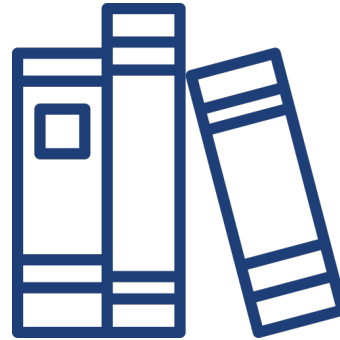

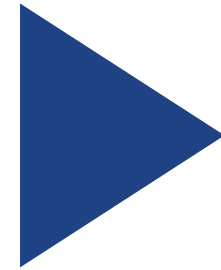
