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





#### **Project Overview**

<u>Purpose:</u> Mill and resurface the existing roadway; install bicycle lanes; and upgrade pedestrian lighting, curb ramps, guardrail connections, signing and pavement markings.

Length: 1.255 miles

**Contractor:** OHLA-USA, Inc.

**Construction Start:** April 17, 2023

**Estimated Contract Cost:** \$2.5 Million

**Contract Time:** 210 calendar days (not including weather and holidays)

**Estimated Completion:** Winter 2023


## Scope of Work SR-615/North 25<sup>th</sup> Street/M.L. King Jr. Boulevard

#### Roadway and Pedestrian Improvements

- Mill and resurface the existing roadway
- Install 6-foot buffered bicycle lanes
- Upgrade pedestrian lighting at the intersection of Juanita Avenue and St. Lucie Boulevard
- Upgrade pedestrian curb ramps to meet Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards
- Upgrade guardrail connections to the existing bridge railings
- Upgrade signing and pavement markings



## **Existing Typical Section From Avenue Q to St. Lucie Boulevard**








#### New Typical Section From Avenue Q to St. Lucie Boulevard







#### **Traffic Impacts & Construction Phasing**

#### **Maintenance of Traffic**

- Work will be done in three (3) major phases to minimize impacts to the construction corridor
- Single-lane closures are permitted as follows:
  - Daytime, Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
  - -Nighttime, Monday through Friday from 7:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.
- Business and residential access will be maintained at all times



#### **Traffic Impacts & Construction Phasing**

#### **Maintenance of Traffic**

- Sections of the sidewalk will be periodically closed, and pedestrian detours will be in place
- During Phase 2, the northbound SR-615/North 25<sup>th</sup> Street/M.L. King Jr. Boulevard westbound turn lane onto Avenue T will be closed for guardrail removal; advance notice will be provided with motorist and pedestrian detours clearly marked

#### Phase 1 A

- -Northbound SR-615/North 25<sup>th</sup> Street/M.L. King Jr. Boulevard
  - Replace sections of the sidewalk and install curb ramps
  - Install new lighting
  - Replace the guardrail and end treatments at the bridge

#### Phase 1 B

- -Southbound SR-615/North 25<sup>th</sup> Street/M.L. King Jr. Boulevard
  - Replace sections of the sidewalks and install curb ramps
  - Install new lighting
  - Replace the guardrail and end treatments at the bridge

#### Phase 2

- -Bridge Work
  - Construct the guardrail that connects to the bridges



Northbound SR-615/North 25<sup>th</sup> Street/M.L. King Jr. Boulevard at Avenue T (pre-construction)



#### Phase 3

- -Northbound and Southbound SR-615/North 25<sup>th</sup> Street/M.L. King Jr. Boulevard
  - Mill and resurface the roadway
  - Remove and install new pavement markings onto the bridge decks
  - Install signing and pavement markings throughout project limits



### Safety and Local Coordination

#### Public Safety is our Top Priority!

- Work Zone Signage & Maintenance of Traffic
  - Advanced warning and project signage will be placed throughout the construction corridor to alert the traveling public

#### Local Agency & Stakeholder Coordination

- The project team will continue working closely with local stakeholders including local municipalities, schools, neighborhoods and other local agencies to ensure safety standards are met and impacts to the public are minimized in any way possible
- Emergency vehicles will be provided access at all times
