SR-5/US-1 Resurfacing Project

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will host a Virtual Public Meeting and In-person Construction Open House regarding upcoming improvements to SR-5/US-1 from SE Contractors Way to north of SR-732/Jensen Beach Boulevard in the City of Stuart. Please see below for detailed meeting information.

Construction Cost: \$12 million

Construction Start: June 2023

Estimated Completion: Spring 2024

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Milling and resurfacing the existing roadway excluding SW Joan Jefferson Way to NW Wright Boulevard (no work on the Roosevelt Bridge).
- Constructing sidewalks to fill in missing gaps.
- Upgrading curb ramps to meet Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards.
- Installing pedestrian pushbutton detectors at signalized intersections.
- Upgrading pavement markings and lighting at signalized intersections.
- Drainage improvements.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Double-lane closures are permitted as follows:
 - Nighttime, SR-5/US-1 within project limits, Monday through Sunday from 8:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.
 - Nighttime, SR-5/US-1 within 600 feet of signalized intersections, Monday through Sunday from 10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.
 - Double-lane closures are permitted at any time at the northbound SR-5/US-1 and SW Ocean Boulevard intersection for drainage work.
- Single-lane closures are permitted as follows:
 - SR-5/US-1 within project limits, Monday through Sunday, as needed.
 - Nighttime, SR-5/US-1 within 600 feet of signalized intersections, Monday through Sunday 8:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.
- Sections of the sidewalk will be closed and pedestrian detours will be in place.
- Business and residential access will be maintained at all times.
