Project Overview

<u>Purpose:</u> Mill and resurface the existing roadway; add bicycle lanes; and, upgrade curb ramps, pedestrian signals, intersection lighting, pavement markings, and signing.

Length: 1.5 miles

Contractor: OHLA USA, Inc.

Construction Start: May 2, 2022

Estimated Contract Cost: \$3 Million

<u>Contract Time:</u> 289 calendar days (not including weather and holidays)

Estimated Completion: Spring 2023


Scope of Work – Roadway Improvements & Upgrades

Roadway Improvements

Mill and resurface the existing roadway

Upgrading features to current standards

- Intersection lighting at NW Sunset Boulevard, NW Goldenrod Road, NW Eugenia Street, and SE Westmoreland Boulevard
- Signing and pavement markings




SR 5/US 1 looking south (pre-construction)

Scope of Work – Pedestrian Features & Upgrades

Pedestrian & bicycle feature upgrades

- Upgrade and construct bicycle lanes within the project limits:
 - 5-feet wide from SR 732/ NW Jensen Beach Boulevard to NW Sunset Boulevard
 - 7-feet wide from NW Sunset Boulevard to the Martin County/St. Lucie County line
- Install pedestrian signals to meet current safety standards
- Ensure all crosswalks and curb ramps within project limits meet Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards

Traffic Impacts & Construction Phasing

Maintenance of Traffic

- Work will be done in four (4) major phases to minimize impacts to the construction corridor
- Lane closures can be expected Monday through Friday:
 - Daytime, single lane closures along US 1, Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
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Traffic Impacts & Construction Phasing

Maintenance of Traffic

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- Pedestrian access will be maintained; should sidewalk closures be required, detours will be clearly marked

Phase 1A

- US 1 Northbound Sidewalk & Curb Ramp, Lighting & Signals
 - Build ADA ramps
 - Install lighting retrofits and pedestrian signals on the east side of the project at NW Sunset Boulevard, NW Goldenrod Road, NW Eugenia Street, and SE Westmoreland Boulevard
 - Construct median modifications, sidewalk and curb and gutter



Northbound SR 5/US 1 (pre-construction)

Phase 1B

- US 1 Southbound Sidewalk & Curb Ramp, Lighting & Signals
 - Build ADA ramps
 - Install lighting retrofits and pedestrian signals on the west side of the project at NW Sunset Boulevard, NW Goldenrod Road, NW Eugenia Street, and SE Westmoreland Boulevard
 - Construct median modifications, sidewalk and curb and gutter

Phase 2A

- Northbound Lanes
 - Milling and resurfacing the inside lanes

Phase 2B

- Southbound Lanes
 - Milling and resurfacing the inside lanes






Phase 4




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Typical section from SR 732/NW Jensen Beach Boulevard to NW Sunset Boulevard
