The City of Port St. Lucie, as Project Sponsor, requested that the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), design and construct the St. Lucie West Boulevard Widening Project through application to the St. Lucie Transportation Planning Organization and City of Port St. Lucie Resolution 20-R75. FDOT is pleased to assist with completing these improvements.

Construction Cost: \$15,518,729 Construction Start: January 24, 2022 Estimated Completion: Winter 2023

EASTBOUND ST. LUCIE WEST BOULEVARD AT COMMERCE CENTRE DRIVE FULL CLOSURE FOR PAVING OPERATIONS

- Eastbound St. Lucie West Boulevard at Commerce Centre Drive, will be closed to traffic overnight, from 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday, Aug. 13 through Thursday, Aug. 17 for roadway paving operations. Sunday, Aug. 20 through Thursday, Aug. 25 will be used as contingency nights if needed.
- Motorists will be detoured via Commerce Centre Drive, Crosstown Parkway, the I-95 northbound onramp from Crosstown Parkway (Exit 120) to St. Lucie West Boulevard (Exit 121).

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Construct a new 3-lane eastbound bridge over I-95
- Widen St. Lucie West Boulevard to accommodate:

 Two (2) eastbound and westbound travel lanes, with a third eastbound lane between the I-95 southbound and northbound ramps
 - Two (2) eastbound left turn lanes at the I-95 northbound entrance ramp
 - Two (2) westbound right turn lanes at the I-95 northbound entrance ramp
- Reconstruct/widen the I-95 ramps
- Connect the existing St. Lucie West Boulevard roadway to the new eastbound bridge from the east and west
- Construct a 7-foot buffered bike lane, paved shoulder and new sidewalks on both sides of the roadway
- Construct a median with curb and gutter (varying in width from 22 feet to 40 feet)
- Install fencing retrofits on the north side of the existing bridge, and new railing on the eastbound bridge
- Install new traffic signals with enhanced timing and synchronization at I-95 ramps
