SR 9/I-95 SOUTHBOUND OFF-RAMP AT MIDWAY ROAD TO UNDERGO FULL CLOSURE AUG. 28

The SR 9/I-95 southbound off-ramp at Midway Road (Exit 126) will be closed to traffic overnight, 8 p.m., until 6:30 a.m., Monday, Aug. 28 for Wrong Way Vehicle Detection testing. Tuesday, Aug. 29 through Thursday, Aug. 31 will be used as contingency nights if needed. During this closure, motorists will be detoured via southbound SR 9/I-95 to St. Lucie West Boulevard (Exit 121), St. Lucie West Boulevard, the northbound SR 9/I-95 northbound on-ramp from St. Lucie West Boulevard, and northbound SR 9/I-95 to Midway Road (Exit 126).

This work is part of the SR 9/I-95 Northbound and Southbound Off-Ramps at Midway Road Improvements Project in St. Lucie County. Work on this project includes: adding a second left-turn lane to both the SR 9/I-95 northbound and southbound off-ramps at Midway Road (Exit 126), widening and repaving the existing SR 9/I-95 off-ramps, upgrading traffic signals with new mast arm poles and improving signalization timing and alignment, implementing Wrong Way Driving Countermeasure Systems, and upgrading signing and pavement markings.
