SR-714/SW Martin Highway between SW Citrus Boulevard and SW Leighton Farm Avenue to Undergo Full Nighttime Closure, Aug. 27-31



ROADWAY CONSTRUCTION AND PIPE INSTALLATION ACROSS SR-714/SW MARTIN HIGHWAY BETWEEN SW CITRUS BOULEVARD AND SW LEIGHTON FARM AVENUE

- Eastbound and westbound SR-714/SW Martin Highway between SW Citrus Boulevard and SW Leighton Farm Avenue, may be closed to traffic overnight, from 8 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday, Aug. 27 through Thursday, Aug. 31 for roadway construction and pipe installation work. Tuesday, Sept. 5 through Friday, Sept. 8 will be used as contingency nights if needed.
- Small vehicle westbound SR-714/SW Martin Highway traffic will be detoured via SW Leighton Farm Avenue, SW Moore Street, and SW Citrus Boulevard to SR-714/SW Martin Highway.
- Small vehicle eastbound SR-714/SW Martin Highway traffic will be detoured via SW Citrus Boulevard, SW Moore Street, and SW Leighton Farm Avenue to SR-714/SW Martin Highway.
- Southbound SW Citrus Boulevard to eastbound SR-714/SW Martin Highway small vehicle traffic will be detoured via SW Citrus Boulevard, SW Moore Street, and SW Leighton Farm Avenue to SR-714/SW Martin Highway.
- Local traffic between SW Citrus Boulevard and SW Leighton Farm Avenue will be escorted through the work zone by project personnel and off-duty police officers.

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Widen SR-714/SW Martin Highway from a two-lane undivided rural roadway to a four-lane divided urban roadway.
- Widen the bridge over Florida's Turnpike.
- Construct seven-foot buffered bike lanes and six-foot sidewalks on both sides of the roadway.
- Realign SW Leighton Farm Avenue further west to line up with SW Deggeller Court and create a four-legged intersection.
- Install a new closed-drainage system with a retention pond.
- Install signing, signalization, and lighting upgrades.
