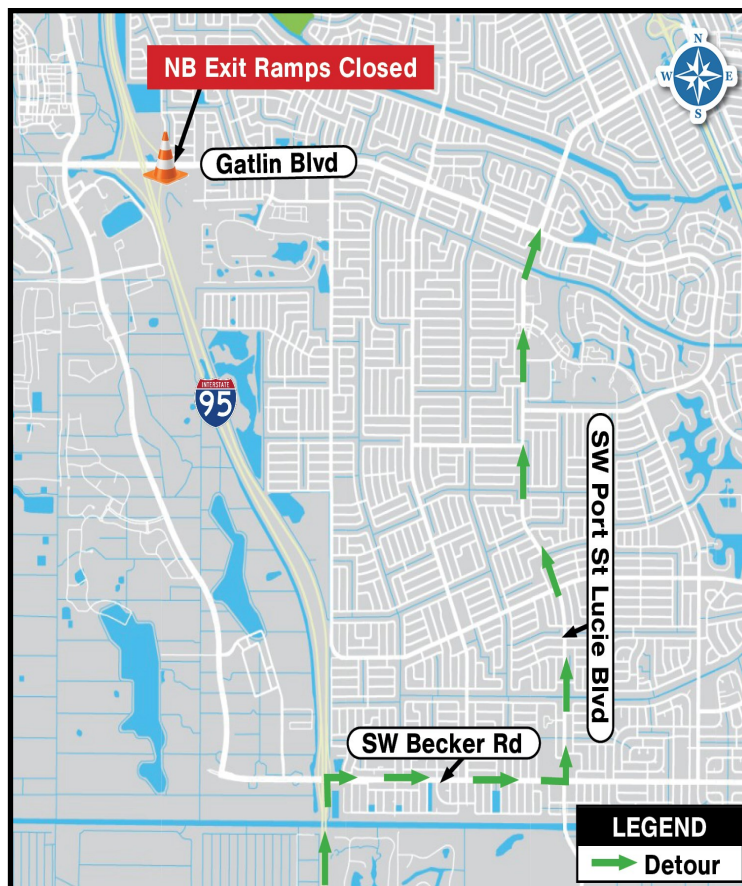

SR 9/I-95 NB OFF-RAMP TO EB AND WB GATLIN BOULEVARD MAY UNDERGO FULL CLOSURE AUG. 1-30

The SR 9/I-95 northbound off-ramp to eastbound and westbound Gatlin Boulevard may be closed to traffic overnight, 9 p.m., until 6 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, beginning Tuesday, Aug. 1 through Thursday, Aug. 31 for milling and resurfacing work. During this closure, motorists will be detoured via the SR 9/I-95 northbound off-ramp to Becker Road (Exit 114), SW Becker Road, and Port St. Lucie Boulevard to Gatlin Boulevard. FHP will be on site to assist motorists. Only one ramp will be closed at a time.

This work is part of the SR 9/I-95 Northbound and Southbound Off-Ramps at Gatlin Boulevard Roadway Improvements Project in the City of Port St. Lucie, St. Lucie County. Work on this project includes: widening southbound SR 9/I-95 to provide a 12-foot auxiliary lane and a 12-foot shoulder (10-foot paved), widening the SR 9/I-95 southbound Gatlin Boulevard off-ramp for the addition of a right-turn lane and a left-turn lane, widening the inside of the SR 9/I-95 northbound Gatlin Boulevard off-ramp to provide three (3) left-turn lanes, widening eastbound and westbound Gatlin Boulevard to provide three 15-foot left-turn lanes, modifying drainage to an open system with dry ponds, installing one cantilever sign structure at the southbound SR 9/I-95 off-ramp, and adding new signing and pavement markings.
