

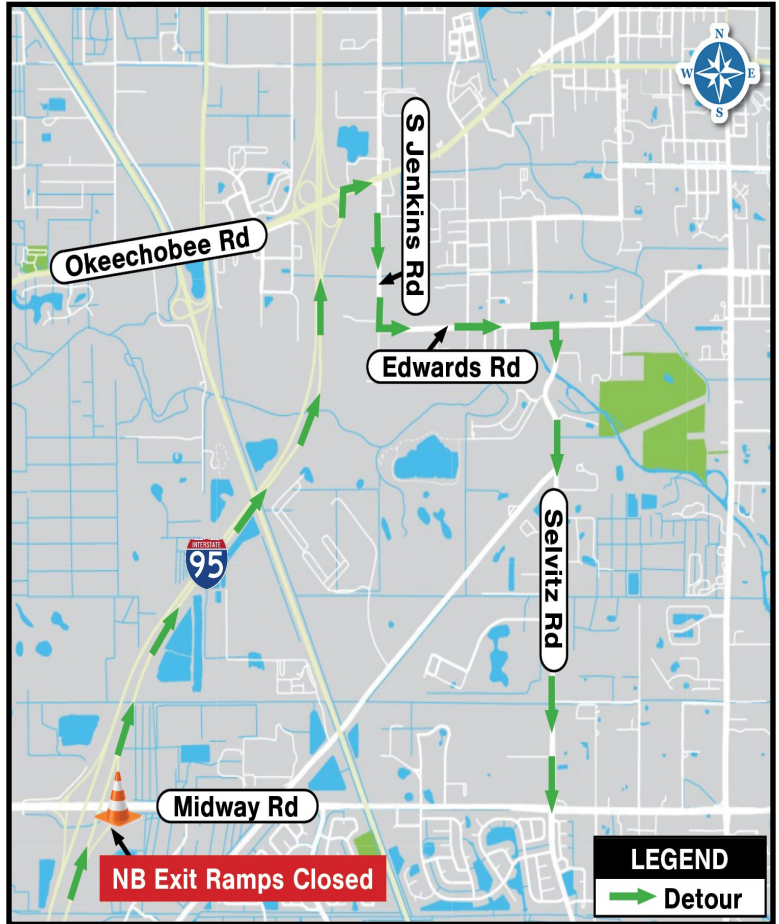

SR 9/I-95 NORTHBOUND OFF-RAMP AT MIDWAY ROAD TO UNDERGO FULL CLOSURE SEPT. 10

The SR 9/I-95 northbound off-ramp at Midway Road (Exit 126) will be closed to traffic overnight, 8 p.m., until 6:30 a.m., Sunday, Sept. 10 for Wrong Way Vehicle Detection testing and final striping. Monday, Sept. 11 through Thursday, Sept. 14 will be used as contingency nights if needed. During this closure, motorists will be detoured via northbound SR 9/I-95 to Okeechobee Road (Exit 129), Okeechobee Road, South Jenkins Road, Edwards Road, and Selvitz Road to Midway Road.

This work is part of the SR 9/I-95 Northbound and Southbound Off-Ramps at Midway Road Improvements Project in St. Lucie County. Work on this project includes: adding a second left-turn lane to both the SR 9/I-95 northbound and southbound off-ramps at Midway Road (Exit 126), widening and repaving the existing SR 9/I-95 off-ramps, upgrading traffic signals with new mast arm poles and improving signalization timing and alignment, implementing Wrong Way Driving Countermeasure Systems, and upgrading signing and pavement markings.
