



Project Overview

Purpose: Construct a left turn lane on SR 710/SW Warfield Boulevard at SW Tommy Clements Street, construct ten-foot paved shoulders, build a retaining wall, and upgrade drainage, signage and pavement markings.

Length: 0.3825 miles

Contractor: Zahlene Enterprises, Inc.

Construction Start: January 3, 2024

Estimated Contract Cost: \$4.8 Million

Estimated Completion: Fall 2024

Contract Time: 324 calendar days
(not including weather and holidays)


Roadway and Drainage Improvements

Roadway and Drainage Improvements

- Constructing a left turn lane on SR 710/SW Warfield Boulevard to SW Tommy Clements Street
- Building ten-foot paved shoulders in each direction of SR 710/SW Warfield Boulevard
- Constructing a retaining wall
- Upgrading drainage, signage, and pavement markings



Maintenance of Traffic

- Single-lane closures on SR 710/SW Warfield Boulevard are permitted Monday through Sunday, from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
- Residential and business access will be maintained at all times.



SW Tommy Clements Street turning right onto eastbound
SR 710/SW Warfield Boulevard
(pre-construction)

Phase A-1

- Reduce the current speed limit from 60 MPH to 55 MPH in the work zone
- Construct SR 710/SW Warfield Boulevard eastbound shoulder
- Install temporary pavement on eastbound shoulder of SR 710/SW Warfield Boulevard
- Reset existing eastbound SR 710/SW Warfield Boulevard shoulder guardrail



SW Tommy Clements Street at the intersection of
SR 710/SW Warfield Boulevard
(pre-construction)

Phase 1:

- Reduce the current speed limit from 60 MPH to 55 MPH in the work zone
- Shift traffic to the south
- Widen westbound SR 710/SW Warfield Boulevard
- Reconstruct the westbound shoulder
- Install guardrail, sheet pile, barrier wall and drainage structures

Phase 2:

- Reduce the current speed limit from 60 MPH to 55 MPH in the work zone
- Mill and resurface the westbound SR 710/SW Warfield Boulevard travel lane
- Install final pavement markings

Phase 3:

- Reduce the current speed limit from 60 MPH to 55 MPH in the work zone
- Mill and resurface the eastbound SR 710/SW Warfield Boulevard travel lane
- Install final pavement markings

 - Advanced warning and project signage will be placed throughout the construction corridor to alert the traveling public

 - The project team will continue working closely with local stakeholders including local municipalities, schools, neighborhoods and other local agencies to ensure safety standards are met and impacts to the public are minimized in any way possible
 - **Emergency vehicles will be provided access at all times**


